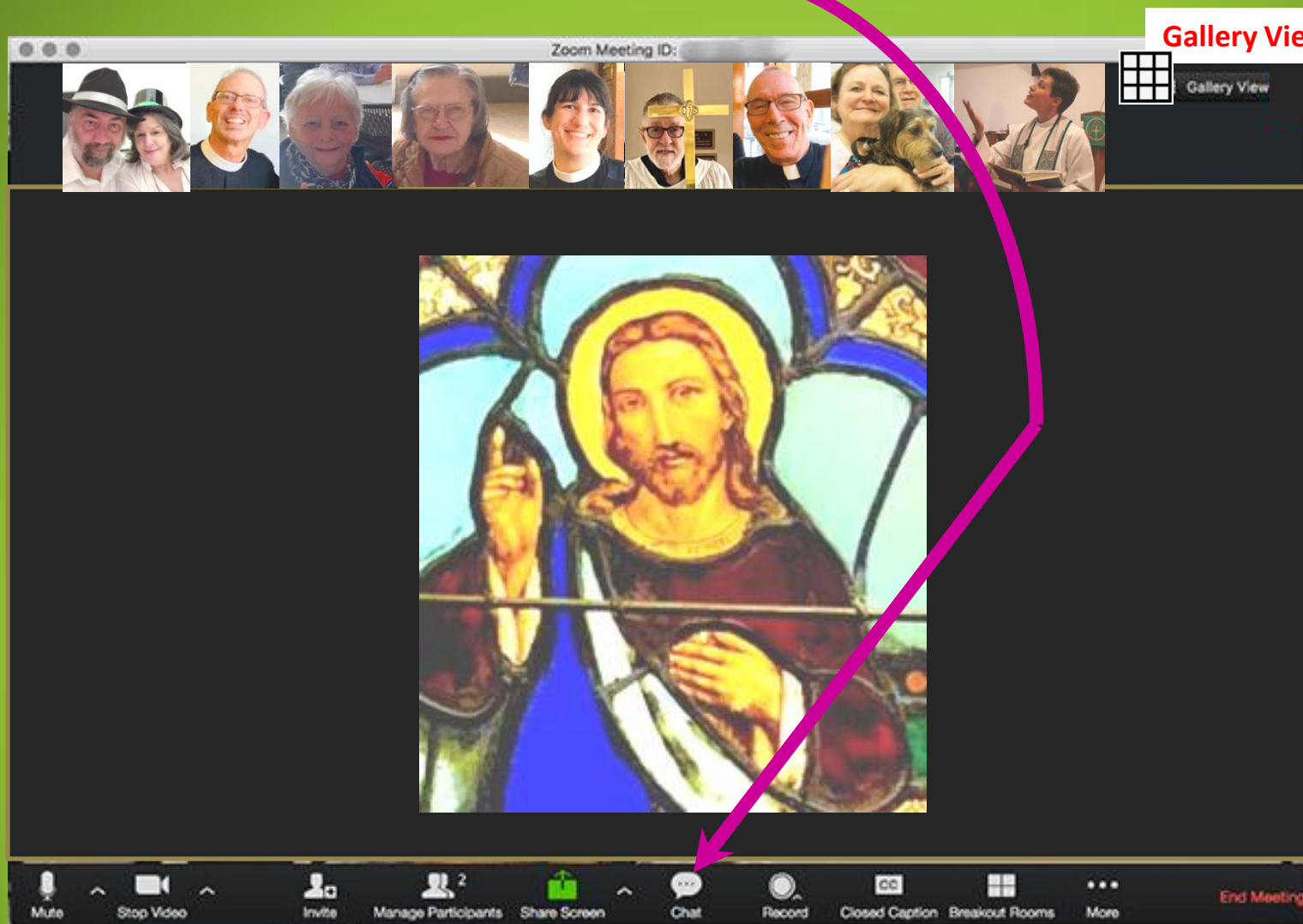
I believe in Jesus Christ, his only son, our Lord.

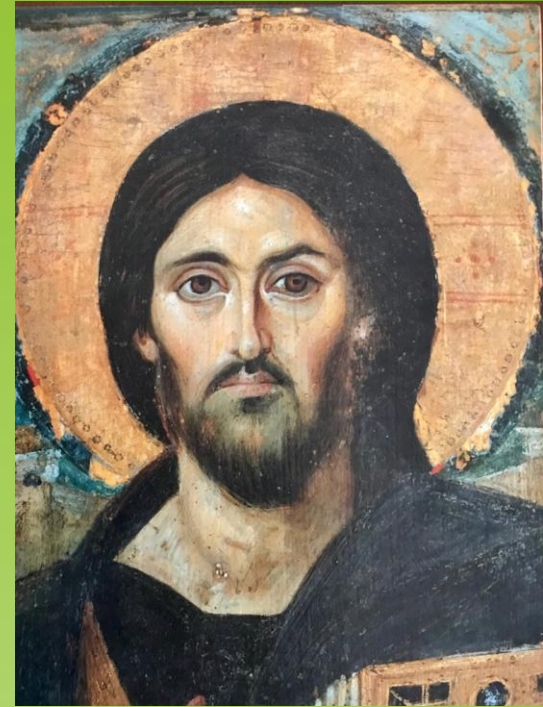

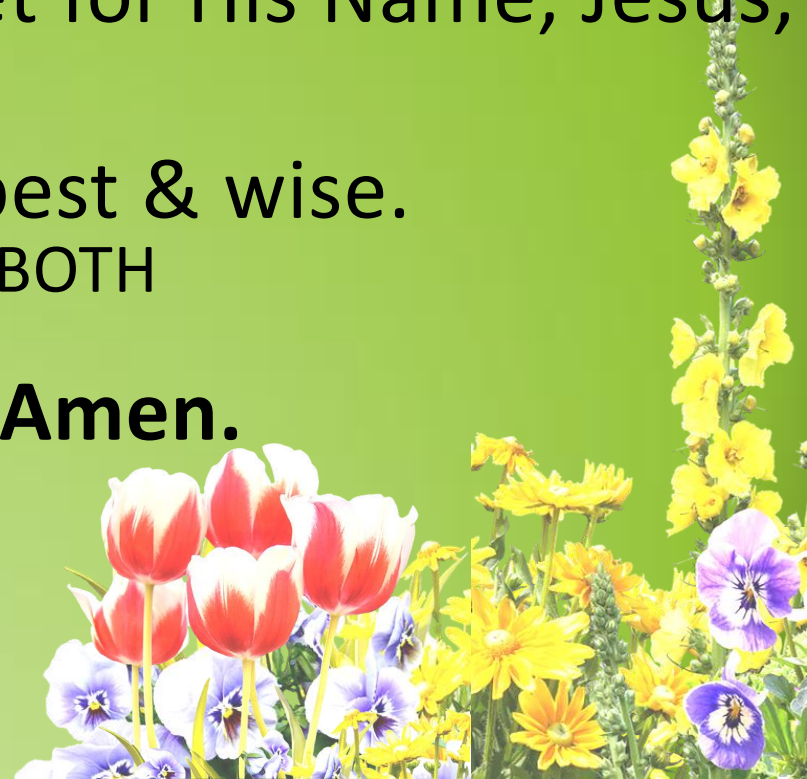

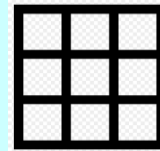
