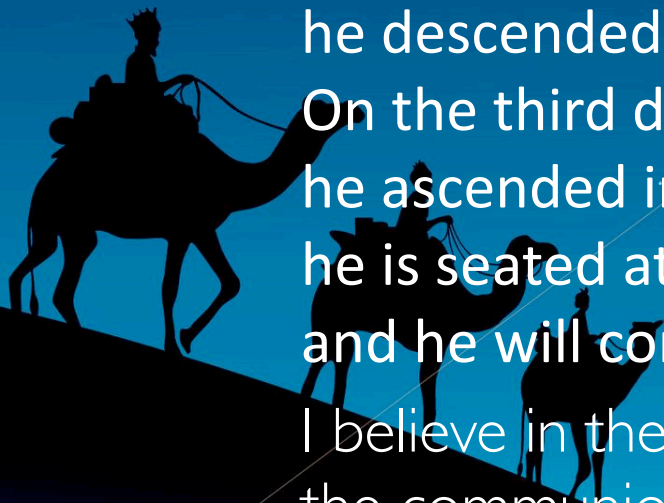

Amen.

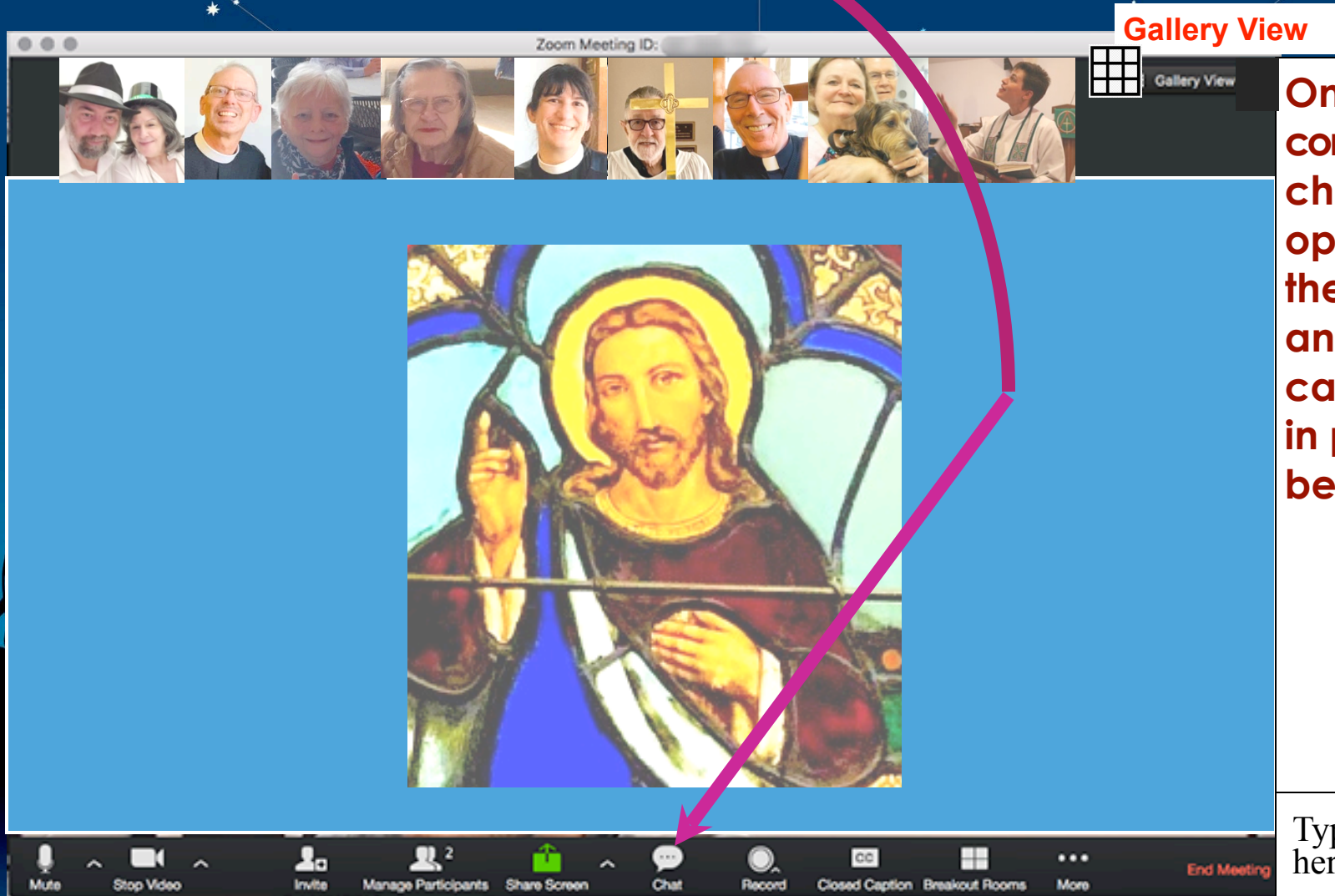

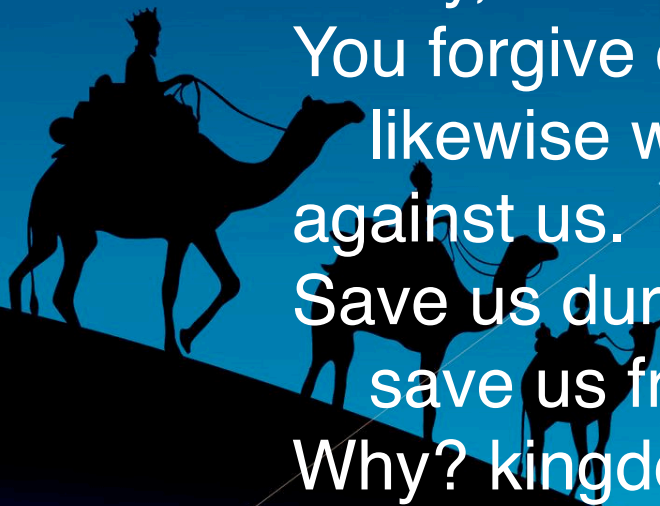
# The Lord's Prayer
