



# A tax refund for Washington workers!

The Working Families Tax Credit will provide payments up to \$1,330 for tax year 2025 to individuals and families who meet the requirements.

## Who is eligible for the tax refund?

Individuals and families are eligible if they meet all of the following requirements:

- Lived in Washington a minimum of 183 days.
- Are at least 25 and under 65 years of age OR have a qualifying child in 2025.
- Filed a 2025 federal tax return with a Social Security Number (SSN) or an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN).
- Eligible for the federal Earned Income Tax Credit on their 2025 tax return (or would meet the requirements for EITC but are filing with an ITIN).

- Meet the income requirements (see table).

## How much will individuals and families get back?

It depends on the number of qualifying children and income level. See table for estimates based on the 2025 income eligibility thresholds.

## What are the income thresholds?

Applicants must earn less than the following amounts to receive the credit.

Number of qualifying children	Single, Head of Household, or Married (filing separately)	Married (filing jointly)	Maximum credit refund
0	\$19,104	\$26,214	\$335
1	\$50,434	\$57,554	\$660
2	\$57,310	\$64,430	\$995
3 or more	\$61,555	\$68,675	\$1,330
