# **Program summary**

Motse Motheo is an English medium school. We welcome children of all nationalities, faiths and creeds. We also welcome children with special needs. The school is open to children aged 18 months to 6 years. The first 3 years of life is very important in child development. It is a period of rapid cognitive, language, social, emotional and motor development.

Our day care program is focused on achieving these developmental milestones. Our curriculum also includes literacy, numeracy, and learning about ourselves and the world around us. It is enhanced by arts and crafts, music and movement and outdoor play, swimming (through a partnership with an external swim school) in addition to our unique character education program. We have a shared reading program. Motse Motheo sends home a story book most evenings of the week for parents to read together with their children. We find that this enhances grasp of the English language.

We pride ourselves in having well equipped classrooms, qualified teachers and a small teacher to child ratio. Children can also enjoy our beautiful and well equipped playground.

### **School Times**

The school has a half day and full day service
