The VIPDC will conduct approved CKC Water Dog Tests for all pointing breeds on March 27-28, 2026 in Parksville BC. Specific location and map will be shared once you have registered.

The Tests are held under the pointing breeds Field Trial and Water Dog Test Rules and Regulations, effective January 1, 2026, of the Canadian Kennel Club, Suite 400-200 Robson Drive, Etobicoke, Ontario, M9W 5Z9

Birds: Dead Chukar, Pigeon or Duck will be used for the Water Tests. Duck will be used for WDX & WDE levels.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- NO OFF LEASH DOGS on property except when running in your event.
- NO PICTURES OR VIDEOING without written permission of the Water Test Chair.
- Blank pistols, .22 cal minimum will be fired over all dogs with bird work. No live ammunition will be allowed in any stake. Pistols must have solid barrels.
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours.
- The Club will accept Day Of entries if there is time and birds available. Please speak to the Event Secretary and note there will be an additional \$10 fee.
- The Club reserves the right to rearrange the running order of the stakes should conditions warrant.
- Collaring a dog away will be allowed with permission of the judge.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run, at the end of the day. **Entrants must notify the event secretary prior to the start of the event , or run will be forfeited.**
- All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Test & Water Test rulebooks are available from the CKC or on-line on the CKC website. <https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations/Field-Dog-and-Water-Test-Rules-and-Regulations-for>
- **It shall be the duty and obligation of the Test-giving Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Water Test is not subject to indignities. The Water Dog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.**
- The Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club is committed to providing an environment free of discrimination and harassment, where all individuals are treated with respect. Members and participants are expected to be respectful at all times. Harassment, discrimination, physical and verbal assault by anyone will not be tolerated, condoned, or ignored within our membership or at any event sponsored or hosted by the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club. Any such claims will be reviewed by the Board. If a claim of harassment or discrimination is determined, disciplinary

measures will be applied, up to and including termination of membership, or suspension from participation in future events for a length of time as determined by the Board.

PRIZES: Standard CKC rosettes will be awarded to the qualifying dogs in all Water tests, as appropriate.

LISTING FEE: A listing fee of \$10.50 as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is per dog per each event entered during the Field Test and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

All entries are accepted on the condition that the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club, its officers, directors, membership and landowners assume no responsibility for participants or spectators in the event of injury or damage to persons, animals, or properties in conjunction with or during the running of the Water Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

BORDER CROSSING: A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into or out of Canada and the rabies certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to crossing the border.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011 Non-member participation fee

a) An annual Non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Test and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club, their members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
