Birds: Dead Chukar or pigeon will be used for the Water Tests.

- Blank pistols, .22 cal minimum will be fired over all dogs with bird work. No live ammunition will be allowed in any stake. Pistols must have solid barrels.
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours.
- The Club will accept Day Of entries if there is time and birds available.
  Please speak to the Event Secretary and note there will be an additional \$10 fee.
- The Club reserves the right to rearrange the running order of the stakes should conditions warrant.
- Collaring a dog away will be allowed with permission of the judge.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run, at the end of the day. Entrants must notify the event secretary prior to the start of the event, or run will be forfeited.
- All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules and provisions of this Premium List. - It shall be the duty and obligation of the Test-giving Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Water Test is not subject to indignities. The Water Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- The Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club is committed to providing an environment free of discrimination and harassment, where all individuals are treated with respect. Members and participants are expected to be respectful at all times. Harassment, discrimination, physical and verbal assault by anyone will not be tolerated, condoned, or ignored within our membership or at any event sponsored or hosted by the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club. Photos of ribbon presentations with judges require participants to wear a Covid mask. Please ensure you bring your own mask to use.

- **LISTING FEE:** A listing fee of \$10.50 as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is per dog per each event entered during the Field Test and is in addition to the entry fee(s).
- All entries are accepted on the condition that the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club, its officers, directors, membership and landowners assume no responsibility for participants or spectators in the event of injury or damage to persons, animals, or properties in conjunction with or during the running of the Field Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.
- **BORDER CROSSING**: A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into or out of Canada and the rabies certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to crossing the border.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011 Non-member participation fee

a) An annual Non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

Access to Nanaimo on Vancouver Island is provided by BC Ferries from either Horseshoe Bay Terminal to Departure Bay just north of Nanaimo or Tsawwassen to Duke Point just south of Nanaimo. Please check with BC Ferries website at www.bcferries.com for official times and fares. Their website is very user friendly. Once you are off the ferry you will take Highway 19 North past Nanaimo until you reach Nanoose Bay, turn right at the light at the Petrocan Station (you are now on Northwest Bay Road). Continue approximately 5 kms until you see the pointing dog signs. Please follow the pointing dog signs to the west edge of the property and refrain from using the main drive to house or barns.
