English Towers Technology Upgrade: Streaming is Here

Arrivederci to DirecTV, Ciao to the freedom of choice through the power of streaming technology. As announced in the *Special Edition of The King's English*, DirecTV will cease connectivity on March 21, 2019. By now you should have returned your Questionnaire indicating any technology choices to the ETCA office. After the DirecTV termination date, Mr. Hobbs and his team will collect the DirecTV boxes and remotes from each unit and deliver them back to DirecTV. Each Serial Number (S/N) will be recorded with the associated unit number so that we have proof of return.

Please ensure that your equipment is accessible; missing equipment is billed back to the unit owner. **You are responsible for calling DirecTV at 800-531-5000 to cancel your individual account invoicing by your account number found on your bill, even if you are billed \$0.** Installation of dual-band routers and Ethernet drops, if

requested, will begin March 5 and continue for about 4 weeks. If you have also requested a Roku or similar product, that will be installed as well. There are numerous streaming service companies from which to choose. **Arrangements with these companies are needed to replace the current DirecTV service with a similar, but user-customized service.** Mr. Hobbs identified that local (Ocean City/Salisbury) channels are available through Hulu + Live TV. Channels local to where you live can usually be obtained through DirecTV Now (not to be confused with your current Amtech DirecTV service). Also, if you have expandable streaming services at your home simply bring your passwords.

Rental agents have been notified that we will be a "streaming property." Unit owners who rent may want to develop a "Renter TV Guide" to advise of the services that you may be providing thus assuring the best experience for your renters. Always remember to log out of personal streaming services prior to renter move in to avoid renters from accessing on demand products via the owner account.

Fitness Center Coming Soon!



The English Towers Fitness Center (the old Community Room) has opened! Enjoy treadmills, an elliptical, a bike, a rowing machine, and a training machine. All Fitness Center users are required to sign the indemnification agreement before use. Be sure to read the Fitness Center Rules and sign your Indemnification Agreement in the Office so that your fob can be programmed for access to the Fitness Center which will be open from 6 AM to 10 PM. Renters will receive a specially programmed fob with a refundable \$10 deposit once the Indemnification Agreement has been signed. Children under 15 years of age must be supervised by a parent or guardian (the same as with the pool). A bottle-less water dispenser (bring your own unbreakable container) and sports drink/water vending machine has been added to the Fitness Center.



Winter 2019 Projects

This Winter has been a busy one for the ETCA staff with projects being worked on all over the building. As mentioned above, the Fitness Center was designed, equipment ordered, electricity run, and a Fob system installed. Additional Fob installation are now complete throughout the building with the addition of Fob access to the Office, Shop, and Electric Room as well. The old Game Room was converted to our new Meeting Room. The old equipment was moved out, the room was freshly painted, and two flat screen television monitors were installed to allow for presentations during meetings. A snack machine was relocated to the north entrance area and the Coke machine is now located just outside of the East door near the walkway to the beach. The parking garage ceiling has been under construction for the past two months. Damaged concrete has been repaired and new spray foam insulation has been installed bringing the ceiling up to current building code and providing some additional energy efficiency to the building. The pool underwent deck cleaning and installation of LED lights in the shallow end – the entire building has now been upgraded to LED lights! New secondary exhaust fans were installed on the east end of the pool building to help reduce the heat buildup in the Summer. New Rules and Regulation signs were posted including Health code rules such as “NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED IN POOL.” Please take the time to read the signs and help us follow the guidelines set by the

State. The State of Maryland issued English Towers a "Certificate of Excellence" for the pool in 2018 and we would like to receive one for the upcoming 2019 year.

As everyone comes through the Lobby, notice that the office is being updated. We are updating walls and furniture and de-cluttering. Doors to owner units and hallway doors on each floor have been grinded to remove rust and are being sealed and painted. This work is expected to be completed by SunFest (September 19-22), weather permitting. These are just some of



the projects we have been working on as well as continuing with the very successful Fee-for-Service program.

- **LABOR CHARGE** for all services: Minimum of half hour or \$25 (\$50/hr. in 15-minute increments after first half hour)
- **PARTS CHARGE:** Cost + 20% and/or owner-provided (good quality to ensure satisfactory results)
