Site Supervision & General Labor

These roles are responsible for day-to-day operations, site safety, and basic physical work.

- **Site Superintendent / General Foreman:** The senior person on-site, responsible for the daily execution of the plan.
- **Safety Officer / Specialist:** Enforces all safety protocols (like OSHA) and conducts hazard assessments.
- **Foreman / Trade Foreman:** Supervises a specific trade crew (e.g., a "Plumbing Foreman").
- **Construction Laborer:** Performs essential, non-specialized physical tasks like site prep, cleanup, moving materials, and demolition.
- **Heavy Equipment Operator:** Operates specialized machinery like cranes, bulldozers, excavators, forklifts, and backhoes.

Specialized Skilled Trades

These are the craftspeople who build the structure and install all functional systems.

Structural & Foundation

- **Ironworker (Structural Steel Erector):** Installs the steel framework of the building.
- **Rebar / Steel Fixer:** Positions and secures the steel reinforcing bars (rebar) in concrete forms.
- **Pile Driver:** Installs deep foundation piles and shafts.

Concrete & Masonry

- **Cement Mason / Concrete Finisher:** Pours, levels, smooths, and finishes concrete for foundations, slabs, and walkways.
- **Brickmason / Mason:** Lays bricks, stones, and concrete blocks for walls and foundations.
- **Stone Mason / Tile & Terrazzo Setter:** Specializes in working with natural stone, marble, and decorative floor/wall tiles.

Carpentry

- **Rough Carpenter / Framer:** Builds the foundational wooden framework (walls, floors, roofs) of the structure.
- **Finish Carpenter:** Specializes in detailed, high-precision work, including installing trim, molding, doors, windows, cabinets, and custom woodwork.

Mechanical, Electrical, & Plumbing (MEP)

- **Plumber:** Installs and maintains water, drainage, sanitary, and sometimes gas piping systems.

- **Pipe Fitter / Steamfitter:** Installs complex, large-scale piping systems (often high-pressure) for industrial or specialized use.
- **Electrician:** Installs, maintains, and repairs all electrical wiring, fixtures, and control systems.
- **HVAC Technician:** Installs and maintains heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and refrigeration systems.
- **Sheet Metal Worker:** Fabricates and installs metal components, most often ductwork for the HVAC system.

Exterior & Interior Finish

- **Roofer:** Installs, maintains, and repairs various types of roofing materials.
- **Glazier:** Installs glass, windows, and curtain walls.
- **Drywall Installer / Taper:** Hangs the gypsum board (drywall) and finishes the seams to prepare for painting.
- **Painter / Decorator:** Applies paint, wallpaper, and other finishes to surfaces.
- **Insulator:** Installs materials to regulate temperature, control noise, and improve energy efficiency.
- **Flooring Installer:** Lays all types of floor coverings, such as carpet, vinyl, hardwood, or laminate.
