
December 14, 2024—Dine and Drive Hosted by the Smiths

Mar. 31, 1932 - Ford introduced the "flathead" V8 in the Ford Model 18. Although the V8 configuration was not new when the Ford V8 was introduced, it was a market first in the respect that it made an 8-cylinder affordable, and it ranks as one of the company's most important developments. 
