WAIVER, INDEMNIFICATION RELEASE AGREEMENT

IN CONSIDERATION OF BEING PERMITTED TO VOLUNTARILY PARTICIPATE (AT MY REQUEST) IN THE EVENT OF MODEL A FORD CLUB OF AMERICA ("MAFCA"), IT'S CHAPTERS, REGIONS AND/OR SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS REFERRED TO BELOW ("EVENT"), THE UNDERSIGNED AGREE(S) TO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE MAFCA, IT'S CHAPTERS, REGIONS OR SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS, THEIR EMPLOYEES, OFFICERS AND AGENTS ("Releases") from all liability to the undersigned, his or her or their personal representatives, assigns, heirs, family members and next of kin ("Releasors") for any loss, damage, or claim therefor on account of injury to the person or property of the Releasors, whether caused by any negligent act or omission or other fault of the Releasees or otherwise while the undersigned is participating in the Event or using any of Releasees' facilities in connection with the Event.
- 2. THE RELEASORS HEREBY AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees rom all liability, claims, demands, causes of action, charges, expenses, and attorney fees and all other costs resulting from involvement in the Event whether caused by any negligent act or omission or other fault of the Releases or otherwise.
- 3. THE RELEASORS HEREBY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF PERSONAL OR BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE while upon Releasee property or participating in the Event or using any Releasee facilities and/or equipment whether caused by any negligent act or omission or other fault of Releasees or otherwise. The Releasors expressly agree that the foregoing release and waiver, indemnity agreement and assumption of risk are intended to be and shall be interpreted and applied as broad and inclusive as permitted by applicable law.

I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE READ THE FOREGOING, THAT I AM VOLUNTARILY ENTERING INTO THIS AGREEMENT AND THAT I AM AWARE OF THE LEGAL CONSEQUENCES OF THIS AGREEMENT, including that it prevents me, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, family members and next of kin from suing the Releasees if I am injured or damaged for any reason as a result of participation in the Event.

IF THE PARTICIPANT IS A MINOR, HIS OR HER CUSTODIAL PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST READ AND EXECUTE THIS AGREEMENT WHERE INDICATED BELOW. 

LUBRICATING LOCKS

THE BEST LUBRICANT I HAVE FOUND FOR CAR DOOR LOCKS, TRUNK HANDLE LOCKS, AND IGNITION LOCKS, RECOMMENDED BY EVERY LOCKSMITH THAT I KNOW, IS DRY POWDERED GRAPHITE.



YOU BUY THE GRAPHITE IN A SMALL TUBE WITH A POINTED TIP. YOU INSERT THE TIP INTO THE KEY HOLE AND "PUFF" SOME GRAPHITE INTO THE LOCK THEN YOU INSERT AND REMOVE THE KEY SEVERAL TIMES TO WORK THE GRAPHITE INTO THE LOCK TUMBLERS, AND OPERATE THE LOCK A FEW TIMES



FINISHING TOUCHES FOR LADIES



Ladies makeup and nails were important details in the Model A Era. Face powder should make the face look velvety and not powdered and should match the skin color. Rouge was worn on the cheeks, but not so much to make you look severe or older. Lipstick should be the same color as the rouge. Mascara was used sparingly on the top lashes but never applied to the lower lashes. Dark brown mascara was recommended and black only used for women with black hair. Eye shadow frequently matched the color of the eyes but by 1931 ladies started to wear eye shadow to pick up the colors of an outfit. Eye shadow should be applied lightly only to the lid. Both eyebrow pencils and mascara were used to darken the eyebrows.

Nails should be oval shaped. Color usually coordinated with the outfits, leaving dark colors for the evening. The nail was painted leaving the "moon" unpainted or painted with clear polish. The French manicure was popular leaving the moon and the nail tip clear. Young girls and homemaker's nails could be buffed to a shine or painted with clear polish. There were no frosted polishes.
