


HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!

As Father's Day approaches, here are some gift ideas from the Model A era:

- (A) The all important robe is a good idea, made of fine light-weight flannel. This double breasted style comes in brown, tan, blue or green with deep and comfortable pockets.
- (B) For the Father who wants to look his best, evening scarves, either in a square style or long and narrow, of white silk brocade are very popular for the dress up events he'll attend.
- (C) Gloves are always appropriate for driving. These are made of pigskin, in buff and black for those sport occasions.
- (D) Leather belts are also a very appropriate Father's Day gift. These are made of sturdy leather, and look very similar to today's styles.
- (E) From England come two traveling cases he'll get a lot of use from. The zippered one is made of pigskin and lined in oiled silk, perfect for his toiletries. The one on the right is more elaborate with containers for his toiletries, nail, and hair care. It also is made of pigskin and lined in silk.



Improve Your Hind Sight



Increase your rearward field of view by applying a "Peel and Stick" type 3 3/4" convex mirror directly on your stock outside rear view mirrors. These convex mirrors are inexpensive and can be found at most auto parts stores and department stores with an automotive department.

The left side mirror by itself is fair, but adding a convex mirror gives you much better coverage. For those of you with right-hand rearview mirrors, you know how little you can see with them. With a convex mirror on the right-hand side mirror you can see almost the entire side of the car from the ground to above the height of the car and well off to the area beside and behind the car.


