Radiator Fluid Check

Some cars have a tendency to throw out fluid from the radiator. To cure this, you can keep the water level lower, as long as the car does not overheat. The problem is how low is it? The baffle obstructs your view. Here's an easy way to check the radiator level.

- Purchase four feet of 5/16" clear vinyl hose at the hardware store.
- Mark one end then slip it on the petcock drain.
- The open end is folded over and crimped with the

left hand. Hold up to the level of the radiator cap.

 Open the petcock and the fluid will rise to the level

that exists in the radiator. If the level is above the

top of the core and the engine is not overheating,


you should be okay to continue on.

•Keeping your left hand up, blow into the

open end of the hose which will force the fluid

back into the radiator.

• Shut the petcock and remove the hose.




