General info

- Programming starts at 12:30 p.m.
- This is a peaceful counter-protest to show there is no space for hate in Manitoba.
- Be aware of multiple concurrent protests.
- 1MillionMarch4Children protesters expected to arrive at the Legislature around 2:00 p.m.
- All Out for Palestine is also happening at 1:00 p.m. in Memorial Park. This protest may attract anti-Palestine counter-protestors.

Safety tips

- Travel and attend with a buddy or in groups
- Plan how you'll get to the counter-protest and back home
- Let people know where you're going and when you'll be home
- Wear comfortable shoes and dress for the weather
- Bring face masks, water, and snacks

Safety tips


- Maintain a safe distance from 1MM4C protestors.
- Do not approach, talk to, or confront people individually.
- If a 1MM4C protestor is provoking you:
- Ignore them and walk away
- Contact a Safety Volunteer
- If a protestor makes threats or displays weapons, immediately move to safety and contact a Safety Volunteer.

Safety volunteers

- Safety Volunteers will be present and wearing high-vis vests. If you see, hear, or experience something that is unsafe or puts others at risk, please tell a Safety Volunteer!
- The Rainbow Wagon will have snacks and face masks and the Backpack Crew (look for the clear backpacks) will have hand-warmers, naloxone, earplugs, first aid supplies, and more.
- Safety Marshalls will be monitoring the crowd, providing safety guidance, and responding to any conflict. They will also be available for safewalks and will have radios to communicate with other safety volunteers and organizers.
- Legal Observers will act as third-party observers who will document police interactions and any disturbances or aggressive incidents.

Onsite Spaces

- The Legislature Steps will feature speakers, a DJ, and performers!
- Kids Zone will have toys, crafts, face painting, and more for kids to play and hang out.
- Safer Spaces Tent is an anti-oppressive safer space near the counter-protest. Anyone who could use a break, support, or resources is welcome.
 Volunteers are available to respond to safer spaces concerns at the event.
- First Aid Tent will have first responders and first aid supplies. Tent and responders will be provided by Klinic. We will also bring along menstrual products and have them available should folks need them. Happy to also give them to someone if they will be distributed elsewhere.

*Safewalks are available to accompany folks to washrooms offsite if needed.

- Do not speak to Winnipeg Alternative Media or fringe media groups. These organizations spread hate and disinformation and may use your words to harm you or your community.
