<u>Griswold Pistol Pit Rules:</u> Handguns and .22 rimfire rifles ONLY on the left/short pit, pistol caliber carbines allowed on the right/long pit. No pistol ammunition larger, or with more muzzle energy than .44 Magnum; if you don't know what

your ammunition muzzle energy is, don't shoot it on the pistol pit - shoot it on the 100-yard range. NO CENTERFIRE RIFLE AMMUNITION may be shot in either pistol pit. DO NOT move the steel targets.
