Pedaling Against Tyranny: How Serbia's Student Protests Exposed the New Face of Authoritarian Repression

Executive Summary

Since November 2024, Serbia has experienced one of Europe's largest student-led protest movements, triggered by the collapse of a train station canopy in Novi Sad, killing 16 people. The protests, demanding accountability and systemic reform, have challenged President Aleksandar Vučić's autocratic rule. Vuk Nektarijević, a 19-year-old engineering student, emerged as one of the most popular students through his leadership in the "Tour de Strasbourg," a 1,300-kilometer bicycle journey to deliver the students' demands to EU institutions. His activism garnered widespread coverage in Serbian, European, and international media, amplifying the protests' global impact.

In response, the Serbian government, led by Vučić and the Serbian Progressive Party (SNS), launched a coordinated campaign to discredit Vuk and his father, Boško Nektarijević, utilizing:

- Over 40 defamatory articles in state-controlled media outlets, including Kurir, Informer, Pink, Blic, Novosti, Alo, MojaTV, Republika, Novi Magazin, Politika, while N1 Info, Nova, and Radio 021, although independent, reported on internal divisions among protesters.
- A bot-driven social media assault involving over 70 X accounts, spreading fabricated accusations and direct threats.
- Suspected involvement of the Serbian security agency (BIA) in leaking personal data and orchestrating intimidation.

This campaign combined weaponized media manipulation, digital psychological warfare, and security service intimidation to destroy Vuk's credibility, isolate him socially, and deter broader youth activism. The tactics mirror hybrid authoritarian strategies observed in Russia, Belarus, and Hungary, posing a significant threat to democratic movements in EU candidate countries.

This report exposes the architecture of repression deployed against Serbia's student movement, documents specific criminal acts including death threats and coordinated defamation, and provides actionable recommendations to empower EU institutions and international actors to confront hybrid authoritarianism and safeguard democratic resilience.

Key Findings


- Hybrid Authoritarian Tactics: The campaign against Vuk (and Boško) Nektarijević employed synchronized media smears, bot-driven X attacks, and security service leaks, reflecting a sophisticated authoritarian playbook using innovative methods and tools.
- Criminal Elements: Several X accounts, including @BalkanOsint, @Johnny_b_032, and @dzoni33a, issued explicit threats of violence and sexual harassment, potentially violating Serbian criminal law (e.g., incitement to violence, defamation).

 Media Orchestration: Over 40 articles across 13 regime-aligned outlets by 25.04.2025 used fabricated screenshots and inflammatory rhetoric, with no verifiable evidence, to label Vuk a misogynist, racist, and psychopath, and Boško a deviant and criminal.

Recommendations for EU Institutions and Criminal Investigators

- Invite activists like Vuk and Bosko Nektarijevic to European Parliament sessions, OSCE panels and
 other relevant events to highlight Serbia's democratic backsliding and expose new methodologies
 and tools used by security services in the AI era.
- Condition EU pre-accession funds on verified democratic reforms. Apply targeted sanctions (travel bans, asset freezes) on Serbian officials, media owners, and propagandists implicated in hybrid attacks.
- Establish real-time counter-disinformation teams using CERV and Horizon Europe Civil Security calls. Fund digital security training and regional safe spaces using CERV and HE
- Investigate X accounts issuing threats (@BalkanOsint, @Johnny_b_032, @dzoni33a) for incitement to violence and defamation under Serbian and EU laws.
- Request by the EU for X to deploy AI-based bot detection tools targeting state-sponsored troll farms.
- Investigate BIA's role in leaking personal data and orchestrating smear campaigns.

Background: The Serbian Student Protests

On November 1, 2024, a concrete canopy at Novi Sad's newly renovated railway station collapsed, killing 16 people, including students, and injuring dozens. Public outrage quickly attributed the disaster to systemic corruption in government contracts, particularly involving Chinese state companies closely tied to President Aleksandar Vučić's regime, which has ruled Serbia since 2012.

Vučić's governance has been consistently marked by judicial capture, with courts subordinated to executive interests; by media monopolization, where independent outlets are harassed, bought out, or marginalized; by the politicization of security services, notably the BIA, which has been deployed to surveil and intimidate opposition figures; by entrenched institutional corruption, with public tenders routinely awarded to regimelinked oligarchs; by a massive youth emigration wave, by persistent election fraud involving documented cases of voter intimidation and total media control during campaigns; and by systematic protest suppression, with previous movements such as "1 of 5 Million" in 2019 facing violence and coordinated smear operations.

The collapse in Novi Sad served as a tipping point. It galvanized a new wave of student-led resistance under the movement named "Serbia, Stop." Students organized campus gatherings, shut down university operations, blocked major traffic arteries, and held silent marches observing 16 minutes of silence in memory of the victims. By March 2025, the protests had expanded to over 400 cities and towns across Serbia, culminating in a massive rally of over 100,000 people in Belgrade on March 15 - the largest public demonstration since the overthrow of Slobodan Milošević in October 2000.

The core demands of the movement included the full disclosure of all contracts related to the Novi Sad station reconstruction; the prosecution of those responsible for the canopy's collapse; the immediate dropping of charges against arrested protesters; the prosecution of those who attacked students during demonstrations; and significantly increased funding and autonomy for Serbia's higher education institutions.

The movement adopted a decentralized, leaderless structure to evade targeting, with decisions made in plenary sessions. Protests remained peaceful, with students cleaning debris to maintain public support. Symbolic actions, like painting hands red to signify government culpability, sustained momentum.

Vuk Nektarijević's Role and the Tour de Strasbourg

Vuk Nektarijević, a 19-year-old engineering student, became a recognizable face due to his activism and articulate advocacy. Quoted in The Guardian (January 30, 2025), he stated, "We are done with corruption, and we are fighting for freedom." His visibility surged across Serbian, regional, and limited EU media through the Tour de Strasbourg, positioning him as a symbolic figure of youthful resistance against authoritarian rule.

On April 3, 2025, Vuk and 80 students cycled 1,300 kilometers from Novi Sad to Strasbourg to deliver a letter to EU institutions, detailing Serbia's democratic backsliding. The tour, aligned with European Parliament sessions, was welcomed in Budapest, Bratislava, and Vienna. On April 15, 2025, Vuk read the letter outside the European Court of Human Rights, addressing French President Emmanuel Macron, emphasizing freedom and EU accountability.

Media Impact

- Serbian Media: Independent outlets (N1, Nova S) praised the students, while regime media downplayed the event.
- European Media: Euronews and AP News highlighted alignment with EU values.
- International Media: The Guardian and Reuters framed the protests as a challenge to Vučić's autocracy.
- Social Media: X posts, including from @EufundsOnline (by Bosko Nektarijevic) celebrated Vuk as a "leading figure."

Coordinated Regime Attack: Media, Security Services, and Social Media Warfare

State-Controlled Media Offensive

Between April 17 and April 24, 2025, 13 regime-aligned outlets published over 40 smear articles targeting Vuk, Boško, and their family. The outlets and their narratives are:

Key Patterns:

- Methodology: Regime bots on X and Instagram misrepresented themselves, such as posing as Defenders of Palestine and similar groups. Then lured Vuk Nektarijevic into sarcastic and ironic replies to their malicious questions.
- Fabricated Evidence: Unverified screenshots of Vuk's alleged "likes" supporting rape or child violence. Whether "likes" are authentic has no evidence. Provided that "likes" are authentic they do not imply support! And bots had immediately misrepresented likes into a criminal public mischaracterization and accusations of Vuk.
- Distorted Content: Old, humorous posts by Boško misrepresented as deviant or criminal.
- False Narratives: Claims of Vuk promoting genocide, mental illness, or family pathology.
- Student Distancing: Attacking all student organizations to abandon Vuk in a massive campaign.
- Tactics: Circular citations, synchronized publication within 48 hours of Vuk's Strasbourg arrival, and reliance on inflammatory rhetoric without evidence.

Additional Context from Naslovi.net (April 24, 2025):

- Kurir's article "Ima li kraja užasu?!" accused Boško of posting a photo of a handcuffed woman (presumed to be his wife) and giving a gun to a minor, implying Vuk's involvement. The sensationalist tone ("Is there no end to the horror?!") aimed to evoke outrage.
- N1 Info, Nova, Novi Magazin, Radio 021, and Politika reported the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering's no-confidence vote against Vuk, citing his alleged social media misconduct, further isolating him.
- The articles, aggregated on naslovi.net, indicate a coordinated effort, with "(1) X (5) (5) Screenshot" suggesting X-based evidence, though no specific accounts were named.

Orchestration Evidence: The 2023 CRTA report ("Mapping disinformation in the Serbian media," January 25, 2023) and Raskrikavanje's 2024 analysis ("Serbian Front Pages in 2023: Six Newspapers, Over 1,150 Manipulations," April 16, 2024) document how state-funded outlets, receiving millions of dinars from Telekom Serbia and municipalities, align with SNS interests, using synchronized manipulations.

Social Media Bot Farm Operations

Over 70 X accounts, many exhibiting bot-like behavior, amplified the media narrative between April 15 and April 22, 2025. Characteristics:

- Account Profiles: ~70% had <500 followers, created post-2023, used generic or AI-generated profile pictures, and posted pro-government content.
- Content Patterns: Identical phrases like "Vuk Nektarijević supports rape" (27 accounts), "fake cyclist" (19 accounts), "Zionist traitor" (14 accounts), with 35 accounts sharing unverified screenshots.
- Hashtags and Timing: #LazniBiciklista, #VukMonstrum, #ZlocinackaPorodica appeared in 42 accounts, peaking April 20–21, 2025, within minutes of media articles.

• Family Attacks: 22 accounts targeted Boško, Anja, and Stefan Nektarijević, calling them a "criminal family" and misusing private photos.

- @dzoni33a: Threatened physical assault (criminal incitement to violence).
- @crveni kmer: Wished harm, linked to Palestinian issues (criminal incitement to violence).
- @cicmilmili: Called for "destruction" of Vuk and family (criminal incitement).
- @pony veverica, @EnderV: Spread false rape-related accusations (criminal defamation).
- @BojanDPCZ, @RankoRubezic: Issued defamatory, sexually offensive remarks (criminal defamation).

Orchestration Evidence: A 2021 Euractiv article and 2020 Foreign Policy Research Institute report document SNS troll farms, with the 2023 CRTA study noting similar tabloid amplification on social media.

Security Service (BIA) Involvement

Circumstantial evidence suggests BIA participation:

- Substantial circumstantial evidence suggests BIA involvement. Leaked personal data whereabouts
 appearing in regime-aligned media strongly indicate that security service resources were mobilized
 to surveil, intimidate, and orchestrate public character assassination campaigns
- Intimidation: Protester Luka Stojaković reported BIA surveillance and data leaks targeting activists' families.
- Historical Precedent: BIA's targeting of .opposition figures (e.g., Slavko Ćuruvija assassination, Otpor crackdowns) aligns with current tactics.

Broader Suppression Tactics

- Fabricated Incidents: Vučić falsely claimed students assaulted police during an RTS blockade, debunked by video evidence.
- Sonic Devices: On March 15, 2025, protesters reported symptoms consistent with Long-Range Acoustic Devices (LRAD), illegal for crowd control.
- Physical Attacks: CINS documented 88 attacks on protesters, SNS-linked individuals assaulted students, including hit-and-run incidents.

Social Media Bot Farm: Structure, Behavior, and Impact

Composition and Characteristics

- Scale: Over 70 accounts, with ~70% created post-2023, <500 followers, and generic profiles.
- Content: Copy-pasted tabloid language, identical hashtags (#LazniBiciklista, #VukMonstrum), and synchronized posting with media releases.
- Linguistic Patterns: Vulgarity, dehumanizing terms (e.g., "rapist," "psychopath"), and family-targeted insults.

Tactics of Amplification

- Hashtag Engineering: Artificial trending of smear hashtags.
- Flooding: Overwhelmed search results with hate content.
- Network Effects: 10–20 bot comments amplified each article within minutes.
- Tagging: Bots tagged regime media to reinforce a false consensus.

Psychological and Social Impact

- Vuk: Induced fear, aimed at withdrawal from activism.
- Boško and Family: Public shaming and isolation.
- Student Movement: Discouraged leadership roles.
- Public Opinion: Discredited protests by framing leaders as "monstrous."

Despite this, Vuk's continued activism demonstrates remarkable resilience.

Implications for EU and Democratic Strategies

Immediate Lessons

- Media Freedom: State-controlled disinformation thrives
- Digital Threats: Bot farms cause significant psychological damage at low cost.
- Security Services: Authoritarian intelligence agencies target civic activism.
- Youth Engagement: Youth movements need rapid international support to counter isolation.

Strategic Recommendations

- Invite activists like Vuk and Bosko Nektarijevic to European Parliament sessions, OSCE panels and
 other relevant events to highlight Serbia's democratic backsliding and expose new methodologies
 and tools used by security services in the AI era.
- Condition EU pre-accession funds on verified democratic reforms. Apply targeted sanctions (travel bans, asset freezes) on Serbian officials, media owners, and propagandists implicated in hybrid attacks.
- Establish real-time counter-disinformation teams using CERV and Horizon Europe Civil Security calls. Fund digital security training and regional safe spaces using CERV and HE

Conclusion

The attacks on Vuk and Boško Nektarijević reveal a state-orchestrated system of repression, weaponizing media, digital platforms, and security services to silence dissent. Over 40 articles across 13 outlets (Kurir, Informer, Pink, Blic, Novosti, Alo, MojaTV, Republika, N1 Info, Nova, Novi Magazin, Radio 021, Politika) and 70+ X accounts falsely portrayed them as criminals, using unverified screenshots and threats. Criminal acts by accounts like @BalkanOsint (death threats) and @Johnny_b_032 (sexual violence threats) warrant immediate investigation. The Serbian student protests, amplified by Vuk's Tour de Strasbourg, challenge Vučić's autocracy, underscoring the urgency of EU action to support independent media, combat disinformation, protect activists, and hold perpetrators accountable. Inaction risks normalizing authoritarian tactics, undermining EU credibility and democratic prospects in the Western Balkans.
