- NEP training programs are designed to help teachers develop the skills and knowledge needed to implement the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The NEP aims to improve education at all levels, from early childhood to higher education.
- ICDS was initially launched in 1975 in one block only. It has been expanded over the years and now covering all Blocks of the State. At the initiation, the criteria of Below Poverty Line (BPL) was considered for implementation of ICDS. However, in 2005 it was expanded to cover all habitations and areas in the entire State

based on health and nutrition status of the beneficiaries instead of the BPL criteria. The scheme is implemented through 62153 Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) in the State.

The scheme is funded by Central and the State Government in the ratio 90:10 for general assistance and 90:10 for supplementary nutrition for all states of NE region.
