#1 THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY, WOOSTER CAMPUS

Since 1892, The Ohio State University's College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences (CFAES) Wooster Campus has been a hub for groundbreaking research and student training aimed at advancing agriculture and sustaining life. Spanning over 3,700

acres of research facilities and farmland, the campus supports the CFAES mission areas of Education, Outreach, and Research through innovative projects and hands-on learning experiences. As part of the 2025 Wayne County Farm Tour, we are excited to showcase our Small Ruminant Unit, located at 5743 Fredericksburg Road in Wooster, Ohio.

Visitors will have the opportunity to observe Ohio State ATI students demonstrating livestock handling skills, answering questions, and sharing insights into careers in agriculture. Newborn lambs will be on site and shearing demonstrations will take place both days of the tour. Under the event tent, younger guests can engage with OSU Extension Wayne County 4-H Junior Fair Board members and interact with sheep, goats, and poultry. The always popular Bug Zoo mobile trailer will also be on-site, offering a fun and educational experience for those curious about entomology.

The CFAES Wooster Campus serves not only the university community but also industry partners. A trailer will be on display that showcase our collaborative work with the OSU College of Veterinary Medicine. The work focused on animal welfare and public health and is now having an impact on disease control and outbreak response. Thanks to generous contributions from industry partners—ranging from seeds and chemicals to equipment and technology—we've developed a goat and sheep grazing pasture demonstration with diverse plant species. This includes a UTV seeding setup equipped with full guidance and application control, highlighting the power of partnership in agricultural innovation. Facilitating interactions with industry and organizations is a significant and impactful differentiator for students attending Ohio State ATI.

Before you leave this stop, be sure to grab a flyer about Grace Drake Agricultural Laboratory as several other tour stops are contiguous to this

#6 STIRRUP COURAGE EQUESTRIAN LEARNING CENTER

This year Stirrup Courage is celebrating five years of sharing a love of horses to support children who face difficult life situations. Founded in November of 2020 by Tara (Gerber) Steiner of Kidron, the nonprofit program offers beginner lessons in horse care and riding to children and teens facing difficult life situations such as foster care, adoption, family separation, grieving loss of a loved one, difficult medical diagnosis, developmental delays, anxiety and depression. By raising money through individual donations, grants, and fundraising events, the program is able to provide scholarships for families who otherwise

could not afford lessons, so that cost is not a barrier for any child who could benefit from participation in the program.

Stirrup Courage Equestrian Learning Center is currently home to 12 horses and ponies, many of which have been donated by people in the local community to help serve the chil-

dren in the program. The facility was completed in fall of 2022 and includes an 8-stall stable, indoor riding arena, and family viewing room area. Director Tara Steiner, her husband Denver, and their four children, Quinn, Thea, Cheyenne, and Kai, live just a few properties north on Kohler Road. Tara directs the program as a full-time volunteer, with the help of a growing team of many wonderful volunteers from the community who believe in the mission of the program. Denver's parents, Dallas and Rhoda Steiner, own the 40-acre farm property where they graciously allowed the equestrian facility to be built.



#7 WOODLYN ACRES

Woodlyn Acres Farm, LLC is located at 647 Kurzen Road S, Dalton. Scott and Nicole Myers are the 4th generation to operate the farm along with their four boys, Gannon, Callum, Rowan, and Henson. Scott's parents, Fred and Cheryl Myers, are still active with the day-to-day activities on the farm. The farm transitioned entirely to certified organic production 10 years ago and raises corn, soybeans, wheat, hay, sunflowers, oats, barley, rye, and peas on over 2,500 acres across the county. Wheat from the farm is sent





to Farmer Ground Flour, a farmer-owned mill in New York, for use in restaurants, bakeries, and direct-to-consumer sales. Flour will be available to purchase at the farm during the tour. Nicole also has a herd of 50 Nigerian Dwarf dairy goats, using their butterfat-rich milk to make handmade soap, which will be offered for sale during the tour.







Come visit the farm, pet the goats, and check out a wide array of farm equipment, and experience many family-friendly farm activities. The Wayne County Soil & Water Conservation District as well as the Ohio Ecological Food and Farming Association (OEFFA) will have displays at this stop. Food and drinks from Smoke Catering Company and the Wayne County 4-H milkshake stand will be available at this stop.



#8 KIDRON COMMUNITY HISTORICAL SOCIETY'S SONNENBERG VILLAGE

Step into history at Sonnenberg Village, a captivating 5-acre heritage site just outside Kidron, Ohio, where Swiss-Mennonite roots and sustainable innovation come to life. Among the village's 12 restored structures, the Gerber/Nussbaum Barn stands as a centerpiece-a stunning, relocated 19th-century bank barn that now hosts cultural events, educational exhibits, and local festivals.





Nearby, the Saurer Blacksmith Shop offers live demonstrations of traditional ironwork, immersing visitors in the craftsmanship that once sustained rural Ohio communities.



Managed by the Kidron Community Historical Society, Sonnenberg Village welcomes guests to explore its gardens, pond, and walking paths while learning about renewable energy,

historic preservation, and community resilience. The annual Farm Tour, a favorite among visitors, provides a unique look into Amish and Mennonite agricultural traditions through self-guided stops, storytelling, and hard to describe farm equipment viewing. It's a rare opportunity to connect past and present in one of Ohio's most scenic rural landscapes.

MAP AND DIRECTIONS

Due to safety concerns, directional signs will not be placed at intersections along the driving route.



From #1 to #2:

Head North on Fredericksburg Rd for 2.3 miles. Turn RIGHT onto US-250 and drive for 2.9 miles. Turn LEFT onto Church St and drive for 0.2 miles. Destination on the left.

From #2 to #3:

Turn LEFT onto US-250. Turn LEFT onto High St/CR-142 and drive for 0.4 miles. Continue onto Millborne Rd/CR-142 and drive for 1.1 miles. Destination is on the left.

From #3 to #4:

Go north on Millborne Rd for 0.8 miles. Turn LEFT onto Ely Rd and drive for 1.0 mile. Turn RIGHT onto Apple Creek Rd and drive for 1.1 miles. Destination on the left.

From #4 to #5:

Go north on Apple Creek Rd for 0.2 miles. Turn LEFT onto E Lincoln Way and the destination is on your immediate right.

From #5 to #6:

Return to Apple Creek Rd and drive north (towards US-30) for 1 mile. Turn RIGHT to follow US-30 E and drive for 5.2 miles. Turn RIGHT onto S Kohler Rd and drive for 0.5 miles to your destination (on the right).

From #6 to #7:

Return to US-30 by heading north on S Kohler Rd for 0.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto US-30 E and drive for 1.6 miles. Turn RIGHT onto Kurzen Rd S and drive for 0.5 miles to your destination (on the left).

From #7 to #8:

Head south on Kurzen Rd S for 0.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto Arnold Rd and drive for 1.1 miles. Turn LEFT onto Kidron Rd and drive for 1.9 miles. Turn LEFT onto Hackett Rd and the destination is on your right in 0.2 miles.
