January 9, 2023:

- Council voted to elect Councilman, Jeff Ling as the council President for the coming year.
- Council voted to obtain Joe Olecki as our solicitor in place of Dave Stimpert.
- Council discussed water shut offs.
- Steve Burns was contacted regarding the muskrats at James Lake. He came out, but saw no sign of mounds indicating an active population.
- Council voted to have a resolution ready at the next meeting to pay back the general fund \$4,000 from what was transferred at the end of December 2022.
- Meeting times will be changing going forward to 6pm.
- Councilwoman, Dottie Scott wants to plan for future projects, set up specifications and get a list going on what council should make priority.

2023 USPS Postage Price Increases:

USPS has implemented the following price increases effective January 22, 2023:

Forever Stamps (a 1-ounce letter) increase to 63 cents

Metered 1-ounce letters increase to 60 cents

Postcards sent domestically increase to 48 cents

International postcards and 1-ounce letters increase to \$1.45.

The certified mail fee, which is in addition to postage and other fees, increases to \$4.15. The fee with an adult signature increases to \$10.80.

Effective Jan. 22, USPS will also increase money order fees and rental fees for P.O. boxes.

VILLAGE HALL RENTALS!



Non-Acceptable Plastics Materials

Loose caps/lids, soap and cleaner pumps, large, refillable 5-gallon water jugs, reusable water bottles, prescription bottles, planters, yogurt, butter, sour cream tubs, peanut butter jars, plastic & styrofoam egg carton, plastic plate or bowl, plastic to-go container, plastic clamshell container, plastic cup, plastic cup lid, plastic utensils, plastic straw, compostable plastic containers and utensils, singleserve coffee pod, plastic grocery bag, bread bag, laundry bag, plastic film, wrappers, bubble wrap, styrofoam items and peanuts, toys, rubber, shoes, tires, plastic furniture, car seat, garden hose, electronics, plastic hanger, diapers, plastic folders and binders

Non-Acceptable Metals

Wrapping paper with glitter, sparkles, velvet, foil, cards with glitter, sparkles, velvet, etc., waxy postcards, receipts, waxy cartons, drink cartons, popcorn bags, soiled/greasy paper take-out bags, napkins, wipes, dryer sheets, toilet paper, tissues, paper towels, paper plates, paper cups, paper togo container, paper to-go bowls, paper straw, compostable paper containers and utensils, wax/ parchment paper, shredded paper, hardback books, cigarettes, envelope with bubble wrap padding, campaign signs

Non-Accepted Cardboard

Food-soiled or greasy cardboard, cardboard can with metal, cardboard fruit crates, no packing material with cardboard

Non-Acceptable Glass

Loose cap/lid, eyeglasses, mirrors, windows, vase, drinking glasses, pottery/ceramics, household items, electronics screens, lightbulbs, broken glass of unacceptable materials

APPLE PIE POPS

These Apple Pie Pops are heart shaped pies filled with cinnamon apples and drizzled with a powdered sugar glaze. Wrap them up with a bow for a cute Valentine's Day treat for a friend.

PREP TIME: 15 MINS COOK TIME: 15 MINS TOTAL TIME: 30 MINS SERVINGS: 10 POPS

INGREDIENTS

- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 cups apples, peeled and diced (about 2-3 apples)
- ¹/₄ cup brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- Pinch of salt
- Pinch of nutmeg
- 1 tablespoon flour
- 1 (14.1 ounce) package refrigerated pie crusts
- 1 Egg

GLAZE:

- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 1 tablespoon milk

MATERIALS:

- Heart shaped cookie cutter, 2-3 inches in diameter
- Lollipop sticks, bags for wrapping, ribbon, sprinkles

INSTRUCTIONS

- In a large skillet, melt the butter. Add the apples, brown sugar, cinnamon, salt, and nutmeg. Cook for 5-6 minutes or until apples are soft. Sprinkle the flour over and cook an additional minute. Remove from heat and cool.
- Preheat oven to 350 degrees and line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
- Unroll pie crusts and cut out hearts. Roll out the scraps and cut out additional hearts. You should have 20 hearts total.
- Beat an egg in a small bowl and set aside.
- Spoon about 1 tablespoon of the apple filling in the center of 10 of the hearts. Place a lollipop stick in halfway up the apple filling (underneath). Using a pastry brush or your finger, brush the outside edge of each heart with the egg wash.
- Top each with the remaining 10 pie crust heart. Using a fork, crimp the edges of the hearts sealing together. Brush tops of the pie crust hearts with egg wash.
- Bake 14-16 minutes or until golden brown.
- For the glaze: In a small bowl whisk together the powdered sugar and milk. Add more or less sugar to desired consistency. Using a fork drizzle over apple pie pops and top with sprinkles if using. Eat or wrap in bags and tie with a ribbon for a gift.
