



POP BOTTLE TERRARIUM



Supplies

- Plastic pop bottle
- Potting Soil
- Scissors
- Small Pebbles
- Small Plant(s)

STEPS

I. Cut the bottle

 With the scissors or an Exacto knife, cut the empty pop bottle at the top of the label and the bottom so it is in three pieces.

2. Lay the base

 In the bottom part of the bottle place the pebbles followed by the potting soil. This will give the plant drainage.

3. Add the plant(s)

 Add the plant(s) to the soil, taking care to cover the roots entirely. You may need to add additional soil to achieve this.

4. Display

 Once the plant feels secure, water it and place the top part of the bottle over the bottom so it is overlapping. Put in a sunny place and enjoy!
