

# Outreach Responsible Pet Ownership Program (RPOP)

This program is to help community members get their animals vaccinated, dewormed, free of fleas, sterilized (spay/neuter), and microchipped at low cost. Animals who are not sterilized are likely to have behavioral and health problems. Vaccines, deworming and parasite control is crucial for the health of the animal. Microchipping is extremely important as it helps the animal be returned to its owner if lost/stolen. For these reasons, we work with a variety of agencies in order to offer this program. Completing this form is not a guarantee of available services. Please contact Mary S. Roberts directly for services and information.

This service offers outreach assistance to our community to help get as many animals sterilized and vaccinated as possible. We often find owners decide to keep their animals after we work with them because sterilization helps with many behavioral problems. Our goal is to keep the animal in the home they know whenever possible.

The cost of the program includes:

Spay/Neuter at Mary S Roberts \$50 FVCRP Vaccine X2 \$30 Rabies vaccine for pets over 4 months: \$8 Revolution flea control: \$15 Microchip \$20

Additional services available for additional fees include: pain meds \$15, cone \$15, nail trim \$5, lv/cath fluids \$25, deworming, Felv/FIP snap test \$30, pregnant cats, additional services needed during sterilization.

Due to potentially higher risks of viral infection at an animal hospital, all pets must be vaccinated at least 1 time two weeks prior to surgery. It is recommended they have 2 vaccines but not required. Please work with Mary S. Roberts to obtain an appointment. They will need the information in the forms below.

### Instructions for sterilization services:

Pets will need to be dropped off at Mary S. Roberts (MSR) 6165 Industrial Avenue, Riverside on the day of surgery at 7:30 am with an Act 2 Rescue (A2R) representative. You must pick them up no later than 5 pm. MSR charges for late pick ups.

Post-op instructions may vary. Please ask for details, including when to remove bandages. Not removing bandages in the correct time period can result in permanent damage.
