- Tennis court fence repair and tree removal; previously uninsured. Now insured
- River beach new gate, camera and fire pit
- Neighborhood signs refurbished
- Barn French drains, retaining wall, erosion maintenance (labor provided by the HOA board members

Roads:

- All roads in the neighborhood are now state maintained
- A five-year plan is in place to have them all repaved
- Sheriffs jurisdiction of state roads to complain about speeders, etc.

Residents:

- Please be friendly with your neighbors!
- Maintain your yard
- Pressure wash your houses when needed
- Untagged vehicles must be removed from front of your home; a state law
- Your personal pool code is not to be shared, and it will operate beach access as well

Questions/Comments:

 Solar Lights by the road are sometimes problematic. Consider restoring them to power.

- Pool rentals over three day weekends were once not allowed. Now they are. There have been no complaints.
