### Clubhouse rental

• The clubhouse rental/small pools now available for a four-hour block, which is working out well

#### **Pool**

- A safety cover is needed for the large pool, which costs \$9,200.00.
- The invoice is higher than estimated and it is being discussed with Havelock Pool & Spa
- The small pool paint has been chipping. Working on obtaining quotes to have it resurfaced/painted, whichever proves more feasible

#### Roads

- Cherry Branch drive have been patched.
- DOT will do a yearly assessment; they are not doing anymore road work in the neighborhood this year.
- The neighborhood is on a 5-year plan, so within the next 5 years all of the roads should be repayed
- Regarding complaints about speeding in the neighborhood, the DOT will not allow speed bumps or anything of that nature.
