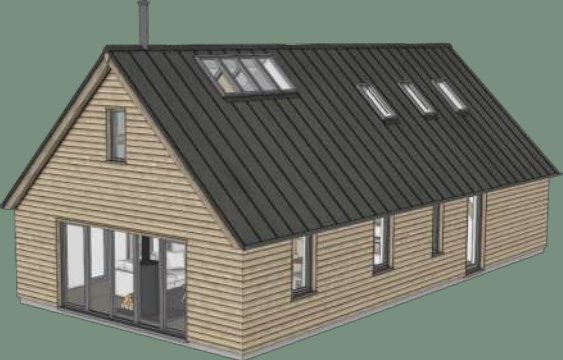

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BAARN Sail Loft



BAARN Sail Loft is the largest home in the BAARN collection, offering four double bedrooms and three bathrooms within a generous, carefully planned layout.

Designed to maximise space and functionality, BAARN Sail Loft showcases an engineered timber frame combined with white-painted joists and rafters to present a calming, coastal aesthetic.

A distinctive covered balcony extends from the principal bedroom, creating a sheltered veranda to the living areas below.

With its generous proportions, crafted detailing and expressive timber structure, the Sail Loft offers a home that feels both refined and deeply welcoming.



Ground Floor Plan

A generous entrance hall with its galleried stairwell, leads into an open-plan living, kitchen and dining space defined by floor-to-ceiling glazing and the expressive timber frame.

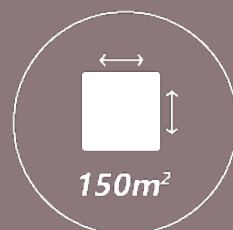
A compact utility / boots space sits neatly beside the kitchen, while two ground-floor double bedrooms and a family bathroom are located away from the living spaces.

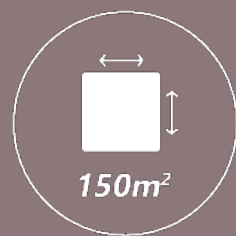


First Floor Plan

Accessed from the upstairs gallery, two first-floor bedrooms sit at either end of the plan, offering privacy and calm.

The second enjoys its own bathroom, while the main bedroom features a walk-through dressing area, a generous ensuite and a private covered balcony for quiet, elevated retreat.

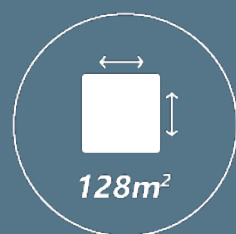
BAARN Norse



BAARN Norse introduces a bold, traditional presence to the BAARN family, blending rural simplicity with a confident modern edge.

Designed around an upside-down layout, its one-and-a-half-storey, three-bedroom form keeps the home modest and sensitive to its surroundings, while generous glazing and a white-washed softwood frame create a clean, sculptural silhouette inspired by Nordic barn heritage.

BAARN Norse is a home that feels rooted in tradition yet unmistakably contemporary.



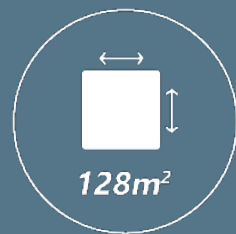
Ground Floor Plan

With a generous covered porch leading to a central entry hall, the ground floor includes two well-proportioned bedrooms, a family bathroom and a bright kitchen-dining space opening to the garden and veranda, creating a practical, welcoming layout rooted in comfort and connection.



First Floor Plan

With upside-down living at its core, the main living space and master bedroom suite are elevated to the upper floor, creating a bright, uplifting environment where light, views and a sense of calm define everyday life.

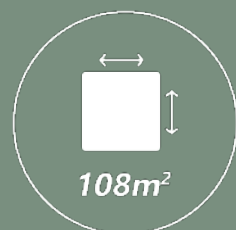
BAARN Loft House



BAARN Loft House distils the character of a traditional barn into a calm, contemporary three-bedroom home. Its single-storey, pitched form and vaulted bays open to the rafters, creating generous volumes washed with natural light and framed by expansive glazing.

A green oak frame defines the interior, bringing warmth, texture and a crafted authenticity that anchors the home in its rural setting. The expressive structure and soaring roofline give the Loft House a quiet, uplifting presence.

Spacious, light-laden and beautifully simple, BAARN Loft House offers a modern barn aesthetic that feels both timeless and unmistakably contemporary.



Ground Floor Plan

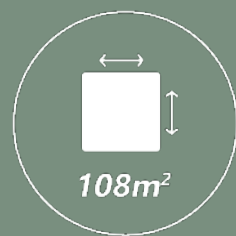
A generous central entry hall leads into the vaulted kitchen, dining and living space, where tall glazing and rooflights flood the space with natural light and emphasise the height and openness of the rafters above.

The hall also gives access to two bedrooms, the family bathroom and a practical utility/boot room with its own back-door entry.



First Floor Plan

The first floor is arranged as an in-the-roof retreat, centred around the master bedroom and ensuite. A galleried study offers views into the vaulted living space below, emphasising the height and openness at the heart of the home.

BAARN Bolthole



BAARN Bolthole refines the barn aesthetic into its most compact, considered form. Designed as a single-bedroom home, it combines the timeless character of a green oak frame with the clarity and simplicity of contemporary living.

Inside, the exposed oak structure brings warmth, texture and a crafted authenticity, while carefully proportioned spaces make the most of the modest footprint. Generous wrap-around glazing to the living spaces draws natural light deep into the home and strengthens its connection to the surrounding landscape.

Compact in scale yet rich in detail, BAARN Bolthole offers an elegant alternative to conventional smaller homes — equally suited to a countryside retreat, weekend escape or beautifully designed permanent residence.



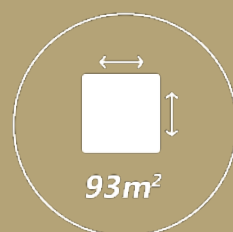
Ground Floor Plan

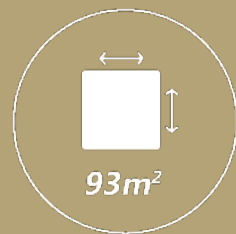
Centred on a generous two-bay living space, the open-plan kitchen, dining and living areas sits beneath a vaulted green oak frame, whilst a well-proportioned double bedroom with built-in storage and a neatly designed bathroom complete the layout.



First Floor Plan

An open stair rising from the living space, leads to a galleried room-in-the-roof that overlooks the two vaulted bays below. This flexible space functions naturally as a home office, reading room or snug area, adding a quiet retreat within the compact barn form.

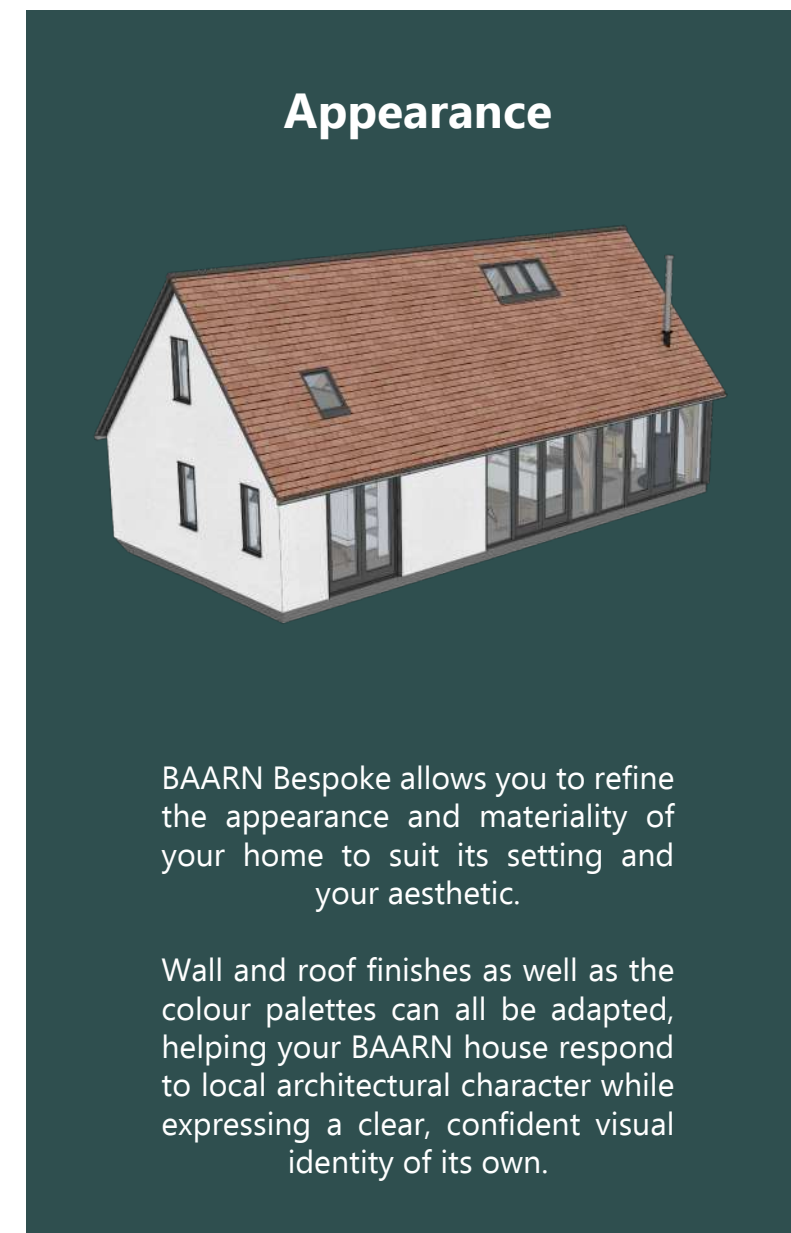
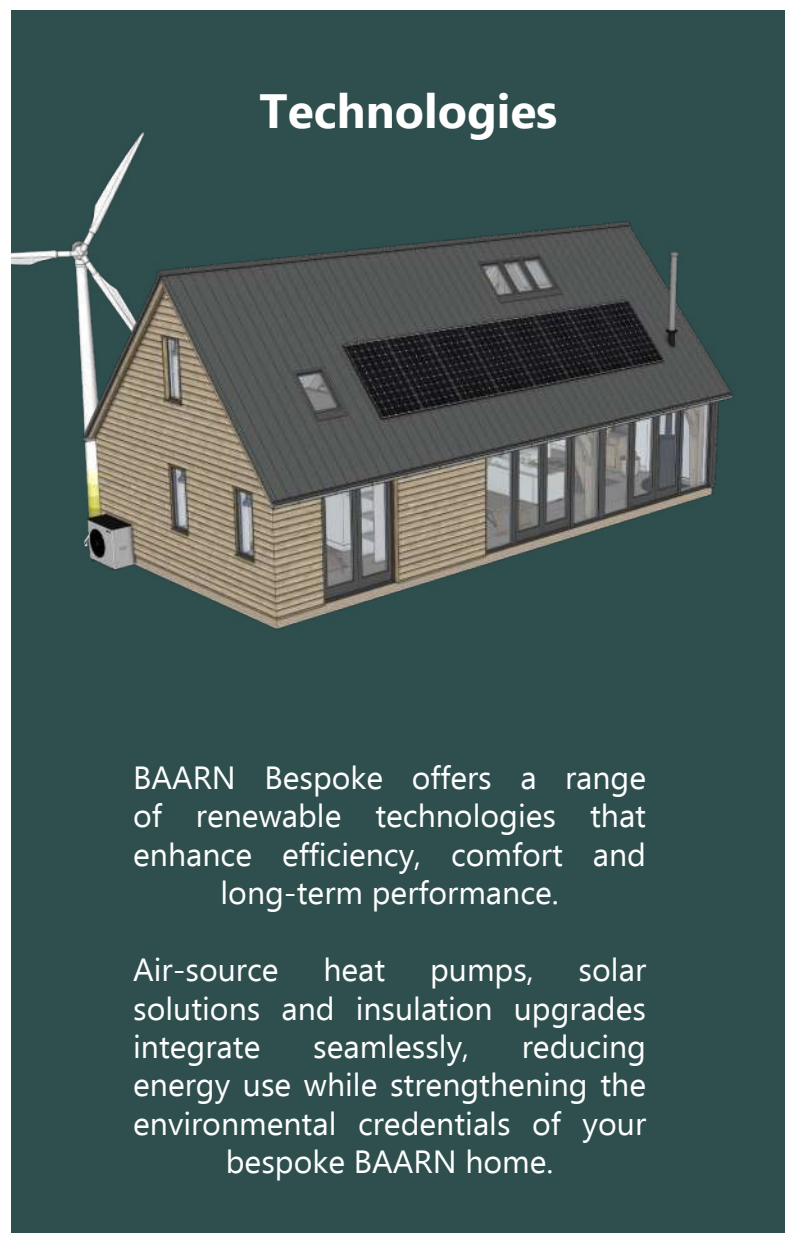

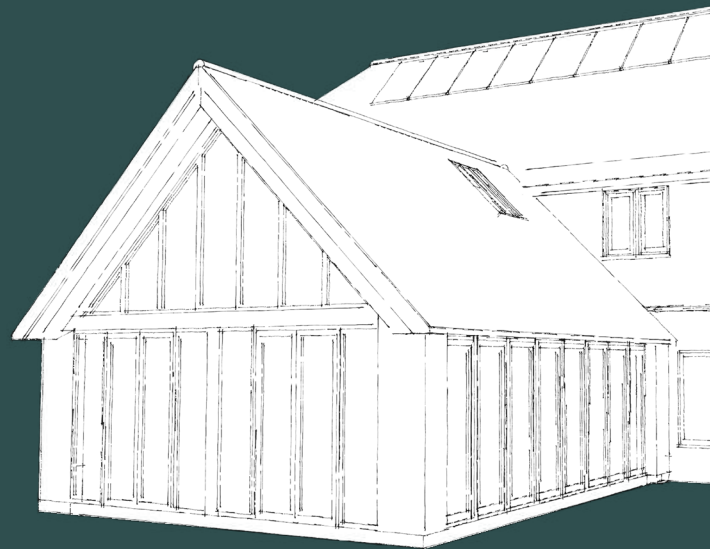
