PreK & Kindergarten

• Arts Center

Block Center

Students are enabled to understand how to use different materials to construct, create and make sense of the way things fit together.

• Dramatic Play Center

Provides the opportunity to experiment with different roles and materials to explore the familiar and unknown through pretend play. Use of imagination, exercise social and emotional skills to make sense of the world.

• Library Center

Story reasoning, print awareness and word recognition are some of the significant literacy skills children begin to develop in this area.

• Science & Math Center

Children develop critical thinking skills while experimenting and exploring science and math concepts that challenge their investigative skills.

Writing & Language Center

Children practice communication through writing as they work on letters and word recognition and formatting words into sounds and putting sounds together to make words.
