Before a walk



Read the walk details and check it is suitable for you



Book a place on the walk if booking is asked for



Notify the walk leader if your plans change and cancel in advance



Bring sufficient food/drink for the length of the walk



Carshare when possible and offer to contribute towards cost



Wear suitable clothing - consider the weather and terrain

On a walk



Be punctual - arrive in advance of walk start times



Tell the Walk Leader or Backmarker of any medical issues or if leaving the walk



Leave no-one behind - respect the pace of all walkers



Follow the countryside code



Safety - you are responsible for your own actions, decisions and safety plus the safety of those around you.



Let the walk leader lead and follow the walk leader's guidance and instructions

Dogs are not allowed on Eryri walks due to the presence of livestock, mountainous terrain or other members being afraid of dogs



Be kind, tolerant and respectful of all members including privacy
