- 1. The Indian Air Force is ever committed towards welfare of our Air Veterans and their family pensioners. With the aim of synergising and synchronising the functioning of various elements/formations working towards pension and welfare of Air Veterans, Directorate of Air Veterans (DAV) was formed on 17 Sep 12 at Subroto Park New Delhi, Consequently, the role of Pension & Welfare Wing at AFRO was transferred to DAV. This Directorate is mandated to deal with pensionary matters/benefits, resettlement, documentation and grievances / representation of IAF veterans and their dependents.
- The directorate is entrusted with the following major responsibilities:-
 - Processing / Settlement of pensionary benefits including service pension, family pension, gratuity, commutation and related entitlements.
 - Management of Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) related matters.
 - 2.3. Handling of grievances / representations.
 - Maintenance of veteran records and liaise with O/o PCDA (P), JCDA(AF) and other agencies for smooth settlement of issues.
 - Coordination for resettlement, reemployment and welfare measures for IAF veterans.
- It has been observed that despite DAV being fully functional, a substantial volume of correspondence from ex-servicemen continues to be addressed to AOC, AFRO. This practice results in duplication of work, unnecessary delays in addressing grievances and diversion of resources from AFRO's primary role of serving personnel record management.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Submission of Annual Life Certificate.

Every Central Government pensioner has to submit Annual Life Certificate in the month of November for further continuation of pension. It has been observed that a large number of Central Government pensioners physically visit bank branches for this purpose.

- 2. As a measure to enable an additional exclusive window to every senior pensioner, this Department, vide its OM No. 1/20/2018- P&PW(E) dated 18.07.2019, has allowed the pensioners in the age group of 80 years and above, to submit Annual Life Certificate from 1st October onwards, instead of 1st November onwards, every year.
- 3. The different modes available to a pensioner for submission of Annual Life Certificate are once again summarized for Pensioners' awareness. An Annual Life Certificate can be submitted manually or digitally as per convenience of the pensioner by following modes: -
- i. Life certificate can be recorded by Pension Disbursing Authorities (PDAs), if the pensioner physically appears before the PDA.
- ii. Personal appearance of a pensioner will not be required, if the pensioner submits the life certificate form signed by any 'designated official'. In accordance with para 14.3 of the Scheme Booklet issued by CPAO, a pensioner who produces a life certificate in the prescribed form, signed by persons specified, is exempted from personal appearance. A list of designated officials specified for signing the Life Certificate as per the scheme booklet of CPAO is attached as Annexure-1.
- iii. Pensioners can submit Life Certificate online through Jeevan Pramaan Portal. The process of submission of Digital Life Certificate, through "Jeevan Pramaan", using fingerprint, may be seen at https://www.youtube.com/cmbed/nNMIkTYqTF8. UIDAI has provided details of all biometric devices which are permissible for capturing biometrics of a person. Pensioners may visit the site www.uidai.gov.in to get information of all such devices.
- iv. Pensioners can also submit Life Certificates using the Face Authentication technology system based on UIDAI Aadhaar software whereby it is possible to generate a Digital Life Certificate from any smart phone by capturing the live photograph of the pensioner for online submission on the Jeevan Pramaan mobile application. IPPB is utilizing its national network of more than 1.41 lakh access points in Post Offices and more than 1.89 lakh Postmen & Gramin Dak Sevaks with smart phones and biometric devices to provide Doorstep Banking Services for generation of Digital Life Certificates. Doorstep Banking is also available through the PSB Alliance comprising Public Sector Banks which do "Doorstep Banking" for its customers in major cities of the country under Ease of Banking reforms. PSB Alliance has introduced the service for collection of Life Certificates under the umbrella of Doorstep Banking. DSB Agent shall visit the doorstep of Pensioner to render the service. Service can be booked by the pensioner through any of the following three channels:

On the demise of a Veteran: Obtain a correct Death certificate matches with the PPO.

Respected Veterans,

- 1. It is to inform all veterans, that on demise of a pensioner, the demise is required to be reported to SPARSH online alongwith death certificate for initiation of case for Family Pension. While doing so, it must be ensured that name in the death certificate should match with that in the PPO.
- In the past there have been cases wherein difficulties were faced by the NOK for initiation of case for Family Pension due to mismatch of name in the PPO and death certificate.
- Kindly be informed of the same and guide your NOK or the other relatives of the deceased veteran to obtain death certificate with the name as in the PPO when attending funeral function to avoid complications at later stage.

Department of Posts Launches Medicine Delivery Service for Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme Beneficiaries

The Department of Posts (DoP), in collaboration with Department of Ex-servicemen (DESW), has launched a dedicated service to facilitate the pickup, booking, transmission, and doorstep delivery of medicines that are not available at ECHS polyclinics under Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS).

Under this initiative, medicines will be procured and packaged through Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLEs) Common Service Centre (CSC) stationed at ECHS polyclinics, while logistics and delivery will be managed by India Post's trusted delivery network. This arrangement ensures that medicines reach ECHS beneficiaries efficiently, securely, and across all corners of the country.

The service was first piloted in Delhi on 31st July 2025 where it received an encouraging response and subsequently expanded to the NCR region, covering Haryana and Uttar Pradesh. Building on the success of the pilot wherein more than 1700 packets of medicines were delivered a comprehensive mapping of 458 ECHS locations across the country has been completed, and the service will be available across the country from 17th October 2025.

ADVISORY: REFERRAL PROCESS IN ECHS

- Refer to CO ECHS letter No. B/49769/AG/ECHS dt 04 Oct 2024.
- It is observed that, special provision w.r.t veterans aged 70 years and above are being misinterpreted by emp hospital leading to harassment to beneficiaries.
- 3. As per Para 2 (c), beneficiary can avail all listed investigations (Including CT Scan, MRI Scan, PET Scan or any other investigation above INR 3,000/-) on a single referral (No separate referral for CT Scan, MRI Scan, PET Scan or any other listed investigation costing above INR 3,000/- is required) if prescribed by the a concerned specialist or specialist of a service hospital or an emp hospital which are genuinely indicated and absolutely necessary.
- 4. It is clarified that beneficiaries 70 years and above can directly avail OPD consultation and listed procedures/ investigations at any emp hospitals without any referral from polyclinic. There is no requirement of taking any referral from polyclinic for listed investigations costing INR 3,000/- and above. All listed investigations (Including CT Scan, MRI Scan, PET Scan or any other investigation above INR 3,000/-) can be carried out with prescription from super specialist or specialist of an emp hospital without referral from polyclinic provided investigations are absolutely necessary and justified.
