REQUEST FOR AUTHORISATION TO ISSUE RECOMMENDATION LETTERS FOR FEE CONCESSION UNDER MOU BETWEEN KIIT AND THE INDIAN AIR FORCE

1. Reference is made to your letter No. AFA/ORI/11186/1/Gen dated 30 Oct 25.
2. 'Project Akashdeep' is an HRD initiative of the IAF aimed at facilitating educational avenues for the IAF personnel and their families. Under the Project, Memorandums of Understanding (MsOU) are inked with civil academia to facilitate earmarked seats, concessional fee, accreditation of the IAF training and other relaxations/ concessions in various Undergraduate (UG), Postgraduate (PG) and Doctoral Research programmes. Accordingly, MsOU with 17 Universities/ Institutes have provisions for concessional fee and/or earmarked seats for wards and/or spouses of IAF personnel. The list of such MsOU is placed at Appendix A to this letter.
3. While some MsOU have provision of concession to unlimited number of candidates, others have restricted the concession to a certain number of seats. Further, to uphold merit and transparency, a system has been put in place which ensured that the concession on limited number of seats is offered to candidates as per the merit prepared by the University. Accordingly, Education Directives have been issued in respect of each University/ Institute which consists of procedure to avail concession/ relaxation under the MsOU.
4. Salient features of procedure laid down in Education Directives, pertaining to Air veterans, are summarised below:-
 - 4.1. Aspiring candidate has to apply directly to the University concerned for admission and has to secure admission at his/ her own merit.
 - 4.2. On receipt of admission offer letter by the candidate from the University concerned, the Air veteran, on behalf of her/ his ward, is to send a request for concession via email (IDs - vigyan-yodha@gov.in and/or jdakashdeep@gmail.com) to Directorate of Education. He is to attach admission offer letter, Discharge book and PPO along with the email containing request for concession. Alternatively, she/ he may send request to Directorate of Education through Dte of Air Veterans, Air Force Association/ Air Force Families Welfare Association.

4.3. On receipt of request at Directorate of Education, the same are scrutinised with respect to eligibility and genuineness for the purpose of concession.

4.4. A consolidated list, in order of merit, of candidates belonging to 'wards of IAF personnel (died while in service/ serving/ retired)' category is also obtained from the University. The same is reconciled with the list compiled from the requests received at Directorate of Education.

4.5. Thereafter, discrepancies, if any, are rectified and the list is put up for perusal and approval of Competent Authority. If the number of candidates seeking concession in the programmes having limited number of seats, are more than the available seats, the concession is offered to candidates in order of merit, as received from the University.

4.6. On approval of the list, the same is shared with the University for offering concessions under the ambit of MOU between the IAF and concerned University. A copy of the intimation is also given to candidate/ Air veterans for their information and necessary coordination with University officials.

4.7. The entire procedure explained above may take three to four weeks to complete. In case of any query/ clarification, the concerned Air veteran may approach Directorate of Education via email and/or telephonically via IAF exchange on 011-23010231/ 200 (AFNet extension: 2112 - 5545 / 5551).

5. It may be pertinent to mention that an MOU is a bilateral understanding between two organisations which are parties to the MOU. The MOU works as enabling framework for recognition of the parties by each other for a specific purpose while maintaining their respective autonomy. Therefore, it becomes imperative on the IAF's part, a party to the MsOU, to ensure that transparency, equality and merit is maintained while facilitating concessions to the candidates.

6. The procedure mentioned in Para 4 of this letter along the annexed list may please be widely publicised amongst Air veterans for maximum yields



Sub: Timing of preparation of first reservation chart.

With a view to inform passengers well in time about the reservation status so as to remove the anxiety of passengers coming from the remote locations to get the long-distance trains, it has been decided to prepare the first reservation charts as follows: -

- i. For trains with departure time from 0501 hours to 1400 hours, the first reservation charts shall be prepared preferably by 2000 hours of the previous day.
- ii. For trains with departure time from 1401 hours to 2359 hours and from 0000 hours to 0500 hours, the first reservation charts shall be prepared preferably at least 10 hours in advance.

2. Necessary instructions may be issued to all concerned accordingly.



ADVISORY : PREVENTING INADVERTENT DISCLOSURE OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION (PII) AND OTHER SENSITIVE DATA – ECHS BENEFICIARIES

- 1. Background.** It has come to light in the recent times that many websites offering free online services are asking the users to upload any random document from their personal **Computers/ Laptops, Smart Phones** etc, to avail for services in return from these websites. As a general tendency and lack of knowledge on misuse of their PII data, the Ex-servicemen/ ECHS beneficiaries uploads their medical documents vis. Referral Forms, Blood Test reports, ECHS application, ECHS card etc. in digital form on these websites.
- 2. Threat to ECHS Beneficiaries.** Sharing medical documents online poses significant risks, including misuse of personal data, identity theft and unauthorized use of health information by third parties. Cybercriminals or unauthorized entities may collect such data for fraudulent activities, including the creation of fake profiles, targeted scams or manipulation of medical information.
- 3. Conclusion.** The protection of PII and other sensitive data is crucial for the security and operational effectiveness of the CO ECHS/ Beneficiaries. All ECHS Beneficiaries are advised **not to share** their medical records, laboratory reports or any personal documents on social media or public platforms.

TELE CONSULTATION THROUGH ELECTRONIC SERVICE HEALTH ASSISTANCE AND TELE-CONSULTATION THROUGH E-SeHAT PORTAL / APP

1. Please ref launching of Pilot Project E-SeHAT wef Oct 2025 (Presently running at Bangalore).
2. On successful trial, the Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) will be providing online medical consultation, tele consultation service to ESM beneficiaries patients via a secure and structured video based clinical consultations as a pilot project in Bangalore.
3. E-SeHAT provides remote access to doctors for video, audio and chat consultations and allows for free delivery of medicines to defence personnel and their families through the Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) via E-SeHAT portal/ app (sehatopd.gov.in).
