

The Killarney Classic. Terms and Conditions of Entry

These Terms and Conditions of Entry ("Entry Terms") are designed to enable The Killarney Classic Sunday 24 th September 2023 (the "Event") to runsafely. By registering and agreeing to the Terms and Conditions of Entry, you (the "Participant") accept and agree to be bound by the Entry Terms and all other relevant material including Event Rules.

Registration Requirements

- 1. A registration is not complete until all necessary participant information is supplied, and full payment is received.
- 2. If the participant is under the age of 12 years old, the participant may only participate in the town ride or fun run.
- 3. The Killarney Classic reserves the right to refuse any registration, without reason for the decision.

Refunds

4. The event is under no obligation to refund registration fees due to failure to participate, injury, mechanical breakdown, or dissatisfaction of the participant.

Support Vehicles

5. Limited support vehicles operate throughout the event. Support vehicles offer limited assistance in the situation of a mechanical breakdown and riders should carry suitable tools/spares to repair common mechanical issues,. While volunteers take due care when handling bikes, the event is not responsible for any damages, costs, or expenses that the participant may incur as a result of the handling of his/her bike.

Acknowledgement and Waiver

- 6. The participant acknowledges and agrees that participation in the event is at his/her own risk
- 7. The participant hereby releases and indemnifies The Killarney Classic, Killarney Bike Classic Association Incorporated and any of their respective representatives, to the extent permitted by law from and against all and any claims, law suits, demands, liabilities, loss and damage, costs, expenses and, interest, whether pursuant to common law or statute, that the participant may suffer or incur arising from or connected with the participants involvement in the event including as a result of negligence, breach of duty, breach of care or other fault or responsibility of The Killarney Classic, Killarney Bike Classic Association Incorporated and any of their respective representatives

If the participant is a parent or guardian of a participant under 18 years of age, that participant consents to the child participating in the event and agrees to take full responsibility for the child's safety and participation throughout the event. The participant further agrees and undertakes to The Killarney Classic for and on behalf of the participant under 18 years of age that the release and indemnity contained in clause 14 applies with full force and effect to the participant under 18 years of age.

Compliance with Laws and Regulations

- 8. During the event, the participant must comply with all road rules and regulations. Participants must always obey with and comply with any direction from NSW Police and The Killarney Classic representatives.
- 9. Any participant involved in a cycling event must wear a securely fitted and fastened helmet that contains a mark of compliance with the Australian Standard and the symbol of a JAS-ANZ accredited company. Any participant found not wearing a helmet will be asked to retire from the event.

Compulsory Equipment and Clothing

- 10. Participants must ensure that his/her bike, equipment, shoes and clothing are suitable for the ride type and distance undertaken during the event.
- 11. Participants must ensure that the bike used is roadworthy and suitable for the event.

Health and Safety

- 12. The participant is responsible for ensuring that he/she has adequately and appropriately prepared physically for the event.
- 13. The participant consents to receiving any medical treatment that event organisers or their authorised representatives (including First Aid and emergency services providers) consider reasonably necessary.
- 14. If the participant becomes ill or injured during the event, and treatment required is beyond First Aid officers as part of the event, an ambulance will be contacted. Any medical transport will be at the participant's expense.

Event Variation

- 15. The Killarney Classic reserves the right to change the route without notice.
- 16. The Killarney Classic reserves the right to cancel, postpone, reschedule, or change tetime and location of the event at any time prior to the event.
- 17. The Killarney Classic is not responsible or liable to the participant for any loss, damage, cost or expense incurred because of such action.

Privacy

- 18. The participant consents to being photographed or filmed during the event, and consents to The Killarney Classic and respective representatives using the participant's photo or film for promoting the event and any future events or business activities by any form of media.
- 19. The parent/guardian of the participant aged under 18 years old consents to the child being photographed or filmed during the event, and consents to The Killarney Classic and respective representatives using the child's photo or film for promoting the event and any future events or business activities by any form of media.
- 20. The participant consents to receiving emails and/or text messages regarding the The Killarney Classic, or any future events held by The Killarney Classic.
