You asked, we listened! Our industry-leading battery powered, portable winch has been given a boost and is now available with either 250kg or 500kg pulling capacity. The unique advantage of the Portawinch is it can be freely transferred from vehicle to vehicle, or even fitted to a wall if assistance is needed up and down a driveway. It detaches in seconds and can be stored away when not in use. This is particularly useful if you have limited floor space.

You can now also upgrade to an in-vehicle charger that plugs directly into the 12v outlet, allowing you to charge your battery whilst on the move!



All our ATOM winches have been updated and now come as standard with our quick-release mounting plate. This clever mechanism puts an end to the time and trouble it takes removing the winch from the vehicle, should you need to. No tools needed, you simply unplug the wiring from the unit, unscrew and remove the moulded cover, then slide the winch off the mounting plate. Et voila!
