

HESI Admissions Assessment Examinations Policy

Admission to the Licensed Practical Nursing Program at Keystone Nursing Academy is determined in part by completion of the HESI Admission Assessment Examinations ("HESI"). The HESI is comprised of three exams: English Language (Reading Comprehension), English Language (Vocabulary and General Knowledge), and Math (Basic Math Skills).

In order to be considered for admission, an applicant must achieve a minimum score of 70% on each of the three included exams.

An applicant will have a total of three attempts per calendar year to take the HESI. Applicants must wait a minimum of 30 days in between each HESI attempt. The highest score from each HESI attempt will be used to calculate the applicant's total points toward admission to the program. HESI scores are valid for up to one year from the original test date.

The initial HESI attempt will be of no cost to the applicant, if scheduled through Keystone Nursing Academy. The cost of additional exam attempts, or attempts scheduled through a third party, will be the responsibility of the applicant.
