Treatment Options

Most patients are referred with an infected tooth. Usually, there are 3 treatment options:

1. **Decline treatment** - This may lead to serious consequences and is not normally recommended.
2. **Endodontics** - Allows you to keep your tooth. We clean and fill the root canals, and your Dentist then places a crown or filling on the tooth.
3. **Extraction** - Your Dentist removes your tooth. Post-extraction options are:
 - a. Leave the space
 - b. Removable partial denture
 - c. Fixed bridge
 - d. Implant
 - e. Orthodontics

Fees *subject to changes*

- Consult only \$300
- Molar \$2400-3000.
- Anteriors/Premolars \$2100 - 2700
- Apical surgery - \$1500-2500
- Extra costs for core restorations, post removal, fracture instrument removal.

Additional costs you should plan for:

Once endodontic treatment is complete, you will need to see your Dentist to have a final filling/crown made for your tooth. You should contact your Dentist beforehand to ask what type of filling/crown is planned and the likely fees involved.

Important information prior to attending your appointment

- Local anaesthetic, dental dam (latex free) and radiographs (x-rays) are required to complete all treatments.
- Post-operative pain or swelling may occur after treatment. We will advise if you need analgesics or antibiotics.
- Complete treatment often requires multiple appointments over 3-months.
- Parental consent is required for patients under 18.

Every tooth is different. Why might your treatment be unsuccessful?

- **Compromised tooth** that is too broken-down, decayed or cracked. We can't save every tooth unfortunately.
- **Complex tooth anatomy** can harbour bacteria that are difficult to clean. Sometimes the infection is beyond the root end; requiring minor surgery.
- **Accidents** - As we are working with micro-instruments, accidents may occur that can affect treatment outcomes. However, this is a very rare occurrence.
