Make a Papier-mâché basin and tripod stand

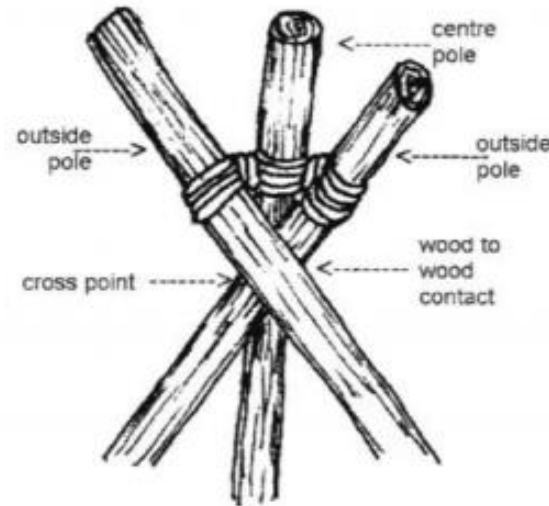
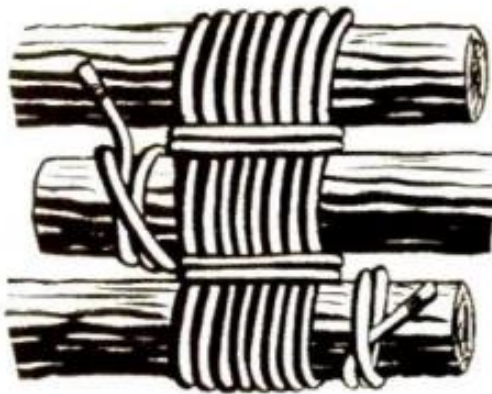
- Cover a balloon or bowl with Papier-mâché
- Wait for it to dry
- Carefully peel from the balloon or bowl
- Trim the top neatly
- Decorate
- Make a tripod stand (next page)

Tripod Lashing



- Make a bowl out of Papier-mâché
- Lash a tripod together using string or wool and sticks, pencils or garden canes
- Paint or colour your laver.
- Fill with paper to imitate water (Do not use real water because Papier-mâché is not waterproof unless you varnish it)

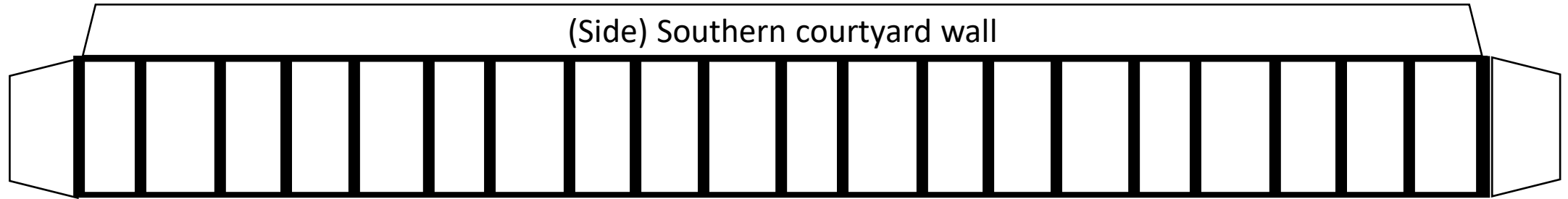
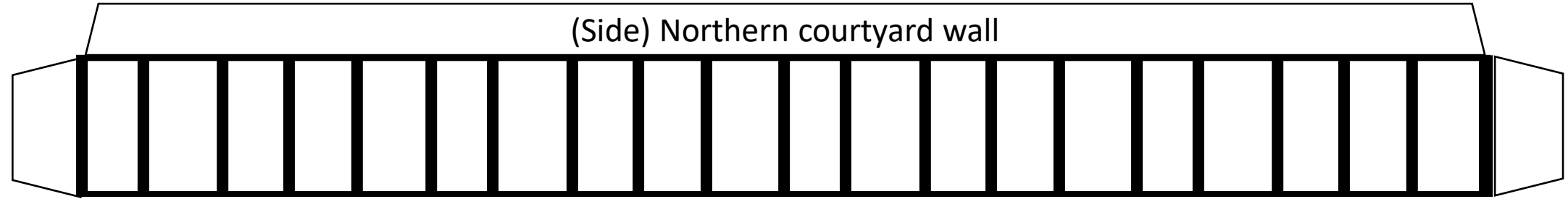
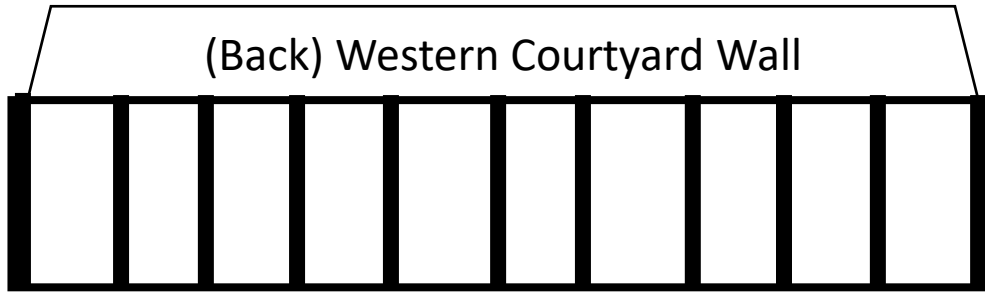
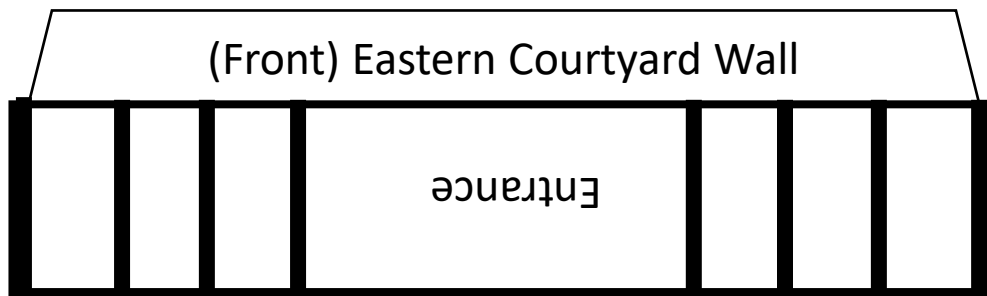
...whom God put forward as a

of the one who has faith in Jesus.

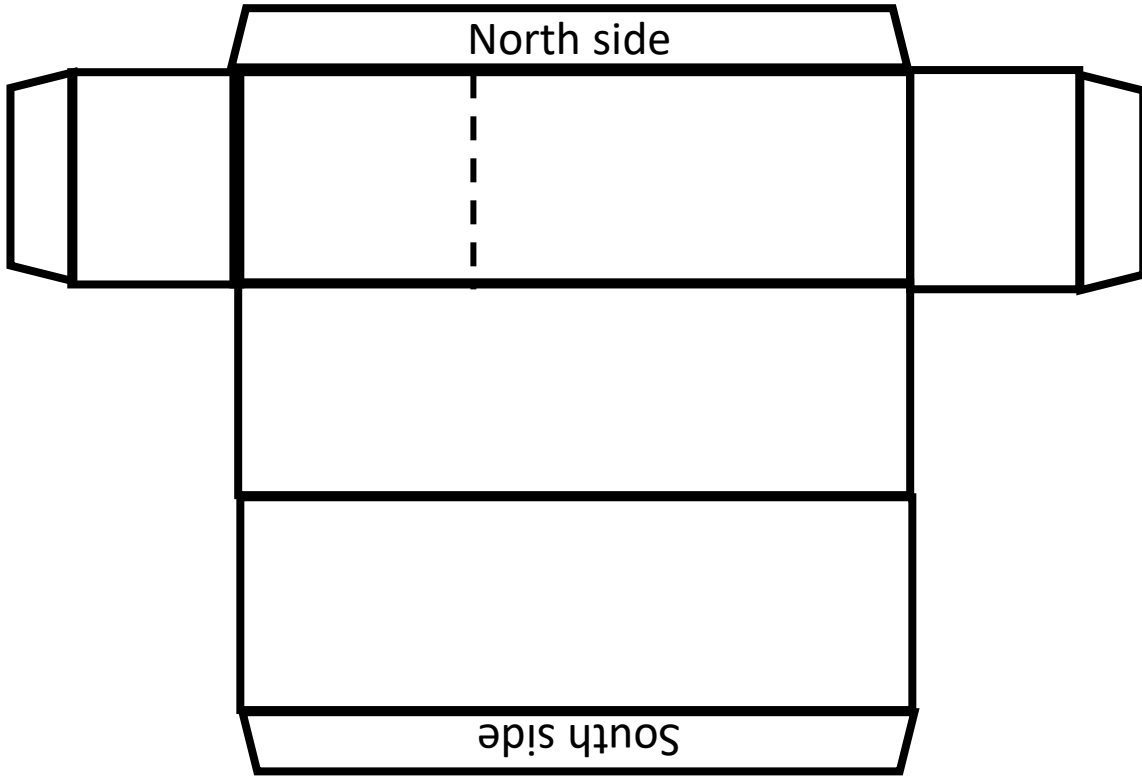

of me.

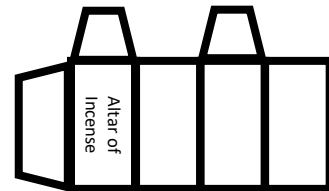
Model of the Tabernacle
(Not to scale)



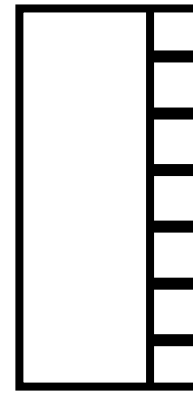




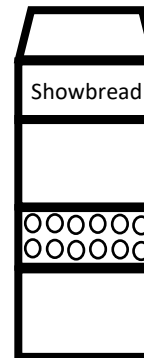
Ark of the Covenant and its mercy seat



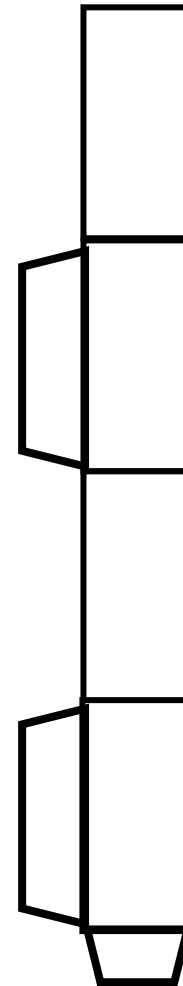
Altar of Incense
