# RESUMPTION OF OPERATION FOR PIVOTED OPERATORS

Nightlife establishments which were previously allowed to temporarily pivot to food and beverage (F&B) operations (pivoted nightlife establishments) must pass inspections and receive a conditional permit from the Ministry of Trade and Industry (MTI) before they can resume operations. Some of the key conditions are as follows:

# POLYMERASE CHAIN REACTION (PCR) & FAST & EAST TESTING (FET)

All staff must undergo a one-time PCR test at approved institutions/clinics and the costs shall be fully borne by the company/staff.

All staff also must undergo 7-Day Fast and easy testing (FET) at HPB Quick Test Centres upon the resumption of operations.



All pivoted nightlife establishments must ensure that following measures are in place to ensure compliance with existing SMMs.







# ONLY MAIN HALL BE ALLOWED

where F&B operations will take place, and the private rooms that will be locked



# ALL ENTERTAINMENT EQUIPMENTS TO BE KEPT

Public entertainment equipment (e.g. pool tables, dart boards, and karaoke machines) are out of sight.



## MANDATORY CCTVS

All pivoted nightlife establishments must install closed-circuit television cameras (CCTVs) to cover all areas of operations including entrances of private rooms. Lighting levels in outlets must be sufficient for activity to be observed on CCTVs.



### CLEAR VISIBILITY

The interior of the establishment must be clearly visible to the public; No blackout windows or opaque doors are allowed.
