## Memorial Garden Project Highlights 6/22/2025

Long-Term Plan is for the Memorial Garden to become an extension of the cemetery with all future garden funds and expenses to be managed through the Cemetery Fund Accounts just as the burial plots are handled now.

The original proposal presented at the meeting focused on temporarily allocating funds from the cemetery account to address the current budget shortfall and to cover any unforeseen expenses related to the completion of the garden project. The intent is for these funds to be repaid through future burial income once the garden is complete. Concern was raised about using cemetery funds that may be needed for perpetual care. Suggestion to utilize funds from the Marion Kuehner Endowment, with the condition that the church honor Marion's memory with a commemorative plaque. Both proposals were discussed. The concern for the funds to come from the endowment would delay the completion of the project. A motion was made to utilize funds from the cemetery account, and move forward with the congregational meeting to request Endowment funds be disbursed for reimbursement. The motion seconded and was passed unanimously. A congregational meeting is scheduled for 7/13/2025 after the 9:00am service but before the picnic!

Financial Summary to date:

Funds Raised: \$77,616.78 - Costs to Date: \$69,215.75

Remaining Funds: Approx. \$6,401.03

(Note: \$2000.00 have been earmarked for paver engravings)

Final Phase of the Project - Estimated Cost: \$36,430.05

(This amount is only to finish the garden and get it ready for burials. It does not include signage for name plates)

Funding Strategy

Utilize surplus from Delores Anello Fund: \$13,466.81

- Funding Gap: Current Shortfall: Approx. \$16,563.24
- As we near completion of the Memorial Garden, we are forming a dedicated Memorial Garden Committee
  to finalize the remaining details needed to begin using the space for burials. The committee will be responsible for addressing the following key areas:

## **Committee Responsibilities:**

Burial Documentation: Establish a clear and consistent process for recording and securely storing burial records.

Burial Locations: Define designated burial spaces and create a layout plan within the garden.

Cost Structure: Determine pricing for burial placements, name plates, and other memorial options.

Name Plates: Set standards for the design, placement, and installation of name signage.

Note: The current project budget does not include funding for name plates. This aspect will require separate planning and fundraising.
