Important Information

From the Food Pantry:

We are averaging 25 boxes every 2 weeks with an estimated cost of \$30.00/box totaling @ \$750.00 every 2 weeks or \$1500.00/month. A HUGE THANK YOU for the congregational food donations we have been receiving. These donations are accounting for about half of the monthly needs. While all food donations are appreciated, the following is a list of the most common foods being distributed: Cereal, Canned Fruit, Macaroni and Cheese, Canned Beans (Pork & Beans), Pancake Mix, Syrup, Crackers, Jelly, Peanut Butter, Boxed Potatoes or Stuffing Mix, Rice/Pasta Packets, Pasta Sauce, Pasta, Soups, Ramen Noodles (Box of 12), Tuna, and Canned Vegetables. Please keep in mind as you go grocery shopping that our need is ongoing and you are able to help your neighbors in a very concrete way by buying extra each time you shop. If you see "Buy One, Get One Free" and only need one item, please take the free item and donate it to the pantry. If canned foods are 5/\$5.00 and you only need two, please consider buying 5 and donating 3. Every little bit helps to support this valuable ministry of our congregation. Sunday School:


Sunday school is going to have it's last day on Sunday June 2nd at 10:00am. They will start back up in September.
