- **Investments:** Experienced a small increase.
- **Attendance** – We’re seeing encouraging growth in attendance at our in-person services. In March 2025, we welcomed 54 attendees, an increase from 46 in March 2024. A highlight this quarter was Palm Sunday, with 110 attendees in 2025, nearly doubling last year’s total of 60. This continued growth reflects the strength and momentum of our congregation as we move forward together.
