# **Septic concern:**

Time to get the septic pumped again. Luke said to wait until we get some rain and more moisture in the ground.

# **Property Committee:**

-There are ongoing issues with the water system, specifically the water softener. Both blue pressure tanks are not functioning and need to be repaired. This is contributing to the corrosion of the copper pipes. The proposed solution includes the following: Installation of an acid neutralizer and a new water softener, Installation of a well tank, Replacement of all existing copper piping with PEX. The **estimated** cost to complete all necessary repairs is \$8,653.

Elevator License ends in November. New 6 month inspection cycle.

**AC Maintenance** bill arrived from Kresge's service at the start of the season @ \$700.

**LED light** replacement in the parking lot bill should be arriving shortly.
