

No Plastics For Lent


In August of 2019, the ELCA Churchwide Assembly gathered and called on the ELCA to get serious about the care of creation. #NoplasticsforLent is being led by young adults/youth across the Churches to remind us to care more for creation. They are challenging everyone to give up single use plastic for the 40 days during Lent.

Are you up for the challenge?

I know, we probably sound like a broken record by now talking about recycling and ditching plastic, but it is so very important!

Did you know that an average person uses about 200 pounds a year, varying from packaging to cups!? That is insane! Plastic is not biodegradable. Meaning that it doesn't decompose like food will, so it sits on our Earth for 100s of years. You may not even realize how much plastic you actually use. Single use plastic ranges from grocery bags to plastic utensils to your favorite coffee shops cups. Those things end up in landfills, and ultimately end up in our oceans. It is a vicious cycle that can only end with you. Bring reusable bags to the grocery store, ditch the plastic utensils, buy a reusable cup for your coffee. All of those minor things, can make a huge difference for our environment!

So I ask you to join our ELCA young adults, and ditch the single use plastic for these 40 days of Lent. You may not first handedly see a difference, but every little bit helps and our Earth will sure see the difference. So go #NoplasticsforLent. The Earth will thank you!

Pastor John Hassler has been serving our Church and surrounding community for 22 years.


Tracey has been a registered nurse for the past 18 years.
