



The Role of the Professional Supervision Monitor

The Professional Supervision Monitor (the “Monitor”) is a neutral third party who is present to ensure safety and report behavioral observations.

All communication with the Monitor shall remain in the text group chat established by the Safe and Sound Visitation Monitoring Leadership Team (“SASVM Leadership”).

Communication with the Monitor may only consist of logistics (e.g., time, date, location) for Supervised Visitation or Monitored Exchange Services (“Services”).

Neither Parent shall attempt to persuade the Monitor to align with them.

The Monitor shall not accept gifts of monetary value (e.g., gift cards, meals, etc.).

Neither Parent shall confront the Monitor at any time. Any and all concerns shall be brought to the attention of SASVM Leadership via email or Concern Form.

The role of the Monitor includes:

- Observing the occurrences of Services.
- Remaining within hearing and visual distance of the Visiting Parent and the Child/ren throughout Services.
- Enforcing Safe and Sound Visitation Monitoring Policies and Procedures.
- Enforcing the Court Order regarding Services.
- Enforcing CA and Federal Laws, as needed.
- Writing non-biased, objective reports, based on what is observed during Services.

The Monitor is **not** responsible for:

- Making changes to the agreed-upon schedule or location for Services.
- Passing information between Parents.
 - The Monitor may pass along information regarding the health and well-being of the Child/ren.
- Moderating conversations between Parents.
- Making suggestions regarding parenting techniques.
- Monitoring food and/or beverage consumption during Services.



- Monitoring the cleanliness or hygiene of the Child/ren during Services.
- Offering counseling or therapeutic services to either Parent or Child/ren.
- Addressing situations or conversations that occur outside of Services.
