

Class of 2022 Project Graduation

Dear Class of 2022 Parents,

Can you believe our children will be graduating in less than a year from now on May 20, 2022? Well, it's both painfully true and wonderfully exciting. And as some of you may know as well – there is another exciting event that comes with graduation – ***Project Graduation!!!***

What is Project Graduation ("PG")??? It is a drug and alcohol free party held for the seniors immediately following the graduation commencement. Your participating senior will be transported to a specially selected site for an unforgettable night of FUN! Everything that is planned is kept secret until the attendees actually get to the site. It is the last party they will attend all together for a long time. The party lasts till dawn when they will meet their parents again back at the school. It is truly the most memorable event in your child's life following their graduation. The entire evening is planned for safety and security and is well chaperoned by parents, alumni and other adult volunteers.

Of course there are costs involved to attend Project Graduation. To offset a large portion of the cost for that night, we ask for donations from the community, have fundraisers, apply for grants through community foundations and charge a fee for each senior that attends. The cost for Project Graduation ranges from \$175.00 – \$275.00 and depends on when you register.

Payment Options and Schedule:

- Money and forms received by Friday, October 8, 2021, the fee will be \$175.00
 - From October 9, 2021 to March 11, 2022, the fee will be \$225.00
 - After March 11, 2022, the fee will be \$275.00
- After May 1, 2022, additional registrations will be accepted upon space available basis and your child may not receive a prize bag.
 - Any payments after March 11, 2022 your student will not receive a T-Shirt and prize bag.

Checks should be made out to: Kaiser PTSA/Project Grad, (Checks or money orders **only, NO CASH**). **PLEASE NOTE ALL REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE* AND NON TRANSFERABLE. (*COVID-19 restrictions will be considered for refunds) We are also working on an online payment option.**

Your child's PTSA registration fee of \$10.00 is included in the total fee. The Project Graduation committee will take care of your child's PTSA registration as all attendees and volunteers must be PTSA members. **The PTSA registration fees are non-refundable*** . Financial assistance is available based upon need. See your child's counselor for more details.

No refund* of the registration fee will be made, even if the senior is a "no show" at the time of bus departure. Parents of the seniors who are "no shows" at the time of the bus departure will be notified by telephone after the bus departs. This phone call will release the Project Graduation Committee of the responsibility of the senior for that night.

Seniors must travel to and from the event location/locations on their assigned bus. For the safety of all concerned as well as for the community at large: Students and Chaperones attending PG 2022 are not allowed to drive immediately after returning from the event. Driving (home or elsewhere) on their own immediately after the event is NOT AN OPTION. All Students & Chaperones must have their parents and/or designated adult drivers pick up the attendees and drive them to their destination after the event. They must be checked out and picked up by a person indicated as a designated driver. (Driver must present identification at time of pick up).

This *event is an **all parent planned*** activity. Kaiser High School and its administration are not involved. It is a Board of Education Sanctioned activity – we NEED your HELP. Parents and other volunteers of the Class of 2022 have already begun the planning for this fabulous event.
