What does the Child Safety Lock Act of 2005 (CSLA) require of a licensee?

When selling, delivering, or transferring a <u>handgun</u> to any person other than another licensee, any licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, or licensed dealer <u>must provide a secure gun storage or safety device</u> to that person for the handgun.

[18 U.S.C. 922(z)]

When transporting a firearm, it MUST be:

- Broken down in a non-functioning state;
 or
- 2. Not immediately accessible;

or

3. Unloaded and enclosed in a case, firearm carrying box, shipping box, or other container by a person who has a valid FOID card;

or

4. Carried or possessed in accordance with the Firearm Concealed Carry Act (430 ILCS 66/) by a person who has a valid Illinois Concealed Carry License
