Participation requires **completion of the Family & Athlete Commitment Agreement** prior to participation.

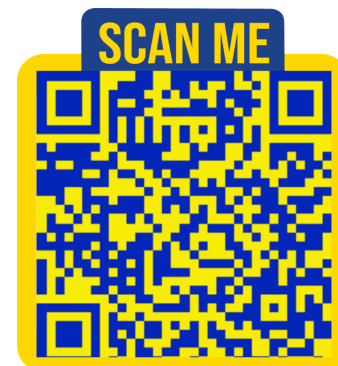
Placement:

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5. Football-Specific Guidelines

Game Day Expectations

- Arrive on time and with all your equipment
- Bring your best effort!
- Maintain energy, focus, and professionalism
- Be a team player
- Maintain your composure and testimony

Practice Expectations

- Arrive on time and ready to participate
- Make sure you are suited up prior to start times
- Consistent attendance during in season is expected
 - Athletes are expected to consistently attend all in-season practices. Attendance impacts playing time and ability to know the plays and positions.
- Practices include fundamentals, conditioning, and learning of plays etc.

Attendance Guidelines

- Conflicts must be communicated in advance
- Repeated absences may impact participation and role opportunities

Safety & Conduct

- Safety is the top priority in all practices and performances
- Athletes must follow all coach instructions
- Equipment should be maintained and brought to each practice.

Uniform & Appearance Standards

- Jerseys should be washed and maintained
- No jewelry
- Remember you represent God, PCHEA and the Team!

- Show respect to teammates, coaches, officials, and opponents
- Demonstrate positive sportsmanship at all times
