## Dinorama Quilt Bonus Instructions Tula Pink ROAR!

When Tula Pink announced her Roar Collection for FreeSpirit Fabrics, we knew we had to revamp our Dinorama Quilt to accommodate these prints! This allowed three of our favourite things to collide: dinosaurs, quilting, and Tula Pink!

The Meteor Showers print was especially exciting for two reasons. First, it allows for creating a fun border on the quilt with minimal piecing. Second, the small-scale print of the central meteor motif acts as a great background fabric for our type of quilt.

## And the Roar version of Dinorama was fully hatched!



These instructions are designed to be used in addition to the main Dinorama pattern. This version of the quilt is the entire quilt found in the original Dinorama pattern with the addition of borders. The borders are made from the Meteor Showers fabric's border motifs and four cornerstones. No matter which version of the quilt you are making, the main body of the quilt goes together in the same way as in the pattern.

In these instructions, you will find fabric requirements, how to cut the borders from your background fabric, a detailed background fabric cutting guide and layout, how to fussy cut the cornerstones and finally, how to assemble and add the borders to the quilt.

If you've purchased the kit for this quilt, you will have received $61 / 2$ yards of the background/border fabric, which is the Meteor Showers print. Following these instructions and the cutting guide carefully, you can get all you need from just $51 / 4$ yards.

To cut your borders, cut two lengths from your background fabric measuring $82^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF and 62" $\times$ WOF. Note that the yardage has a border motif on both sides.

Measure 1" out from the peak of the highest cloud bubble in the border motif, as shown, on both sides of the yardage of both the $82^{\prime \prime}$ and $62^{\prime \prime}$ cuts.


From this point, cut the border motifs off each side of both yardage lengths. This should leave roughly $24^{\prime \prime}$ of meteor motif from the centre of each cut, as shown.

Trim down the border prints on their selvedge sides so they measure $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ in width.

Note that your border motif pieces will be slightly longer than needed, but you will trim them down when ready to apply them to your quilt.

The following two pages contain a background fabric cutting guide and fabric layouts. This is a comprehensive guide for the whole quilt, including the sashing (pieces A, B, and C).

To cut your other fabrics for the quilt, refer to page 2 of the Dinorama pattern, where you will find the cutting guide by block. You will need three blocks for this quilt, all using different fabrics.

From the 24 " x 82" centre cut from the borders


From the 24 " x 62" centre cut from the borders


Remove the border motif from 84 more inches of the Meteor Showers print, leaving approximately 24 " of meteor motif from the centre, just as you have done previously for the $82^{\prime \prime}$ and $62^{\prime \prime}$ cuts. The borders you remove here will not be used in this project.

Subdivide the $84^{\prime \prime}$ cut into two sections measuring $58 "$ and $26^{\prime \prime}$. Following the Cutting Guide, cut the rest of the background pieces, as shown.

From the 58" cut


From the 26 " cut


You are now ready to refer to the Dinorama pattern to cut your other fabrics and assemble the main quilt top featuring the three dinosaur blocks.

Once your main quilt top is complete, you want to make the four cornerstones and borders.

To make the four cornerstones, you will first fussy cut the raptor motif from the Gift Rapt print, as shown.
You will need a total of 4 cuts that measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


From the Stargazer print, cut eight pieces that measure $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ and eight pieces that measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, laying them out, as shown below.

Create the four cornerstones by first stitching the $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ pieces to the sides of each raptor, followed by the $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces to the top and bottom of each raptor, as shown. Press your seam open or towards the outside. The four cornerstones should measure $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91^{1 / 2}$ each.


Measure your main quilt top and trim the border pieces to match. These measurements should be approximately $60.5^{\prime \prime} \times 80.25^{\prime \prime}$.

Stitch the two longest border pieces to either side of the main quilt top, as shown. Press.
Stitch the four cornerstones to either end of the two shorter border pieces, as shown. Press.
Complete your quilt top by stitching the two cornerstone/border pieces to the top and bottom edges of the quilt.

The final dimensions of the quilt top should be $78.5^{\prime \prime} \times 98.25^{\prime \prime}$.
