

Wonderful Woodland Quilt Top Assembly - Small Quilt

CUTTING GUIDE

Background <i>Such as Kona Lake or Essex Flax</i>		
A	1	2.5" x 13"
B	1	2.25" x 13"
C	1	17.75" x 3"
D	1	3.25" x 9.5"
E	2	14.25" x 2.75"
F	1	11.75" x 1.5"
G	2	3" x 11.5"
H	2	1.75" x 11.5"
J	2	41.75" x 2"
K	2	41.75" x 2.5"
L	2	2" x 60.5"

MIDDLE ROW

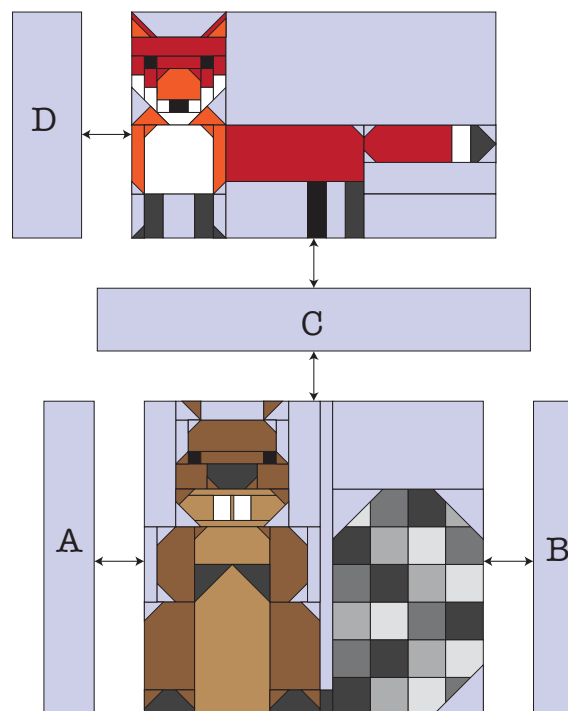
Remove the borders from the **Beaver Block** (oops!).

Once stripped down, stitch piece **A** to the left of the block and piece **B** to the right (*17.75" x 13"*).

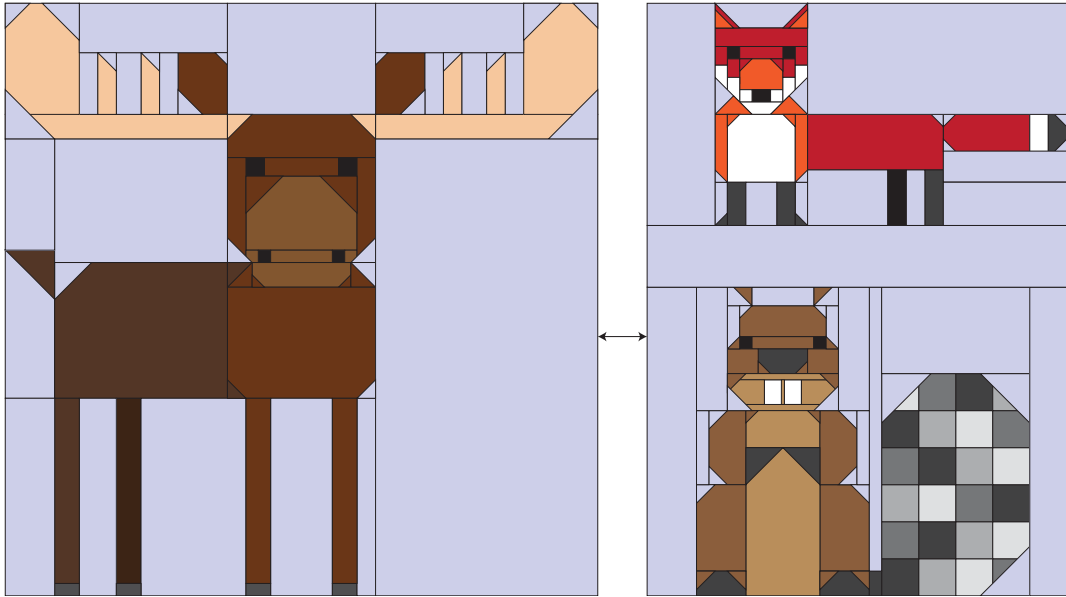
Once pressed, stitch piece **C** to the top of the **Beaver Block** (*17.75" x 15.5"*).

Stitch piece **D** to the left of the **Fox Block** (*17.75" x 9.5"*).

Once pressed, stitch the **Fox Block** to the top of the **Beaver Block** (*17.75" x 24"*).



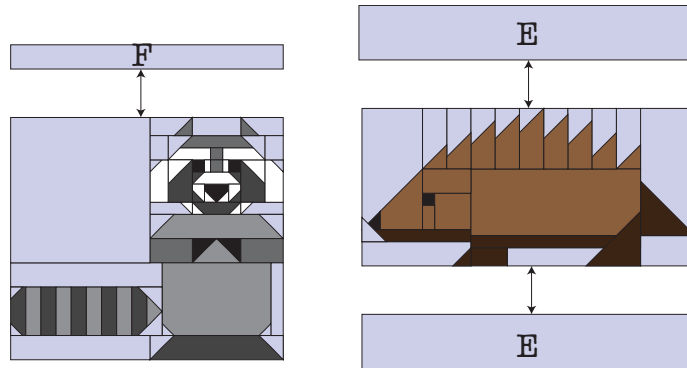
Once pressed, stitch the **Beaver/Fox Block** to the right of the **Moose Block** (41.75" x 24.5"). Place aside.



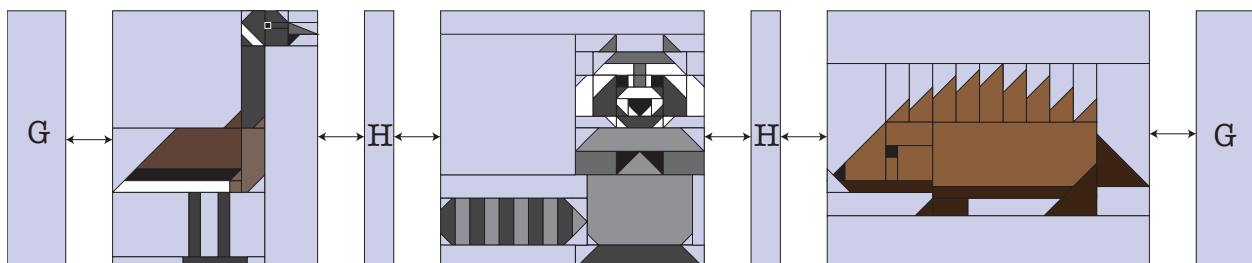
TOP ROW

Stitch the **E** pieces to the top and bottom of the **Porcupine Block** (14.25" x 11.5").

Stitch piece **F** to the top of the **Raccoon Block** (11.75" x 11.5").

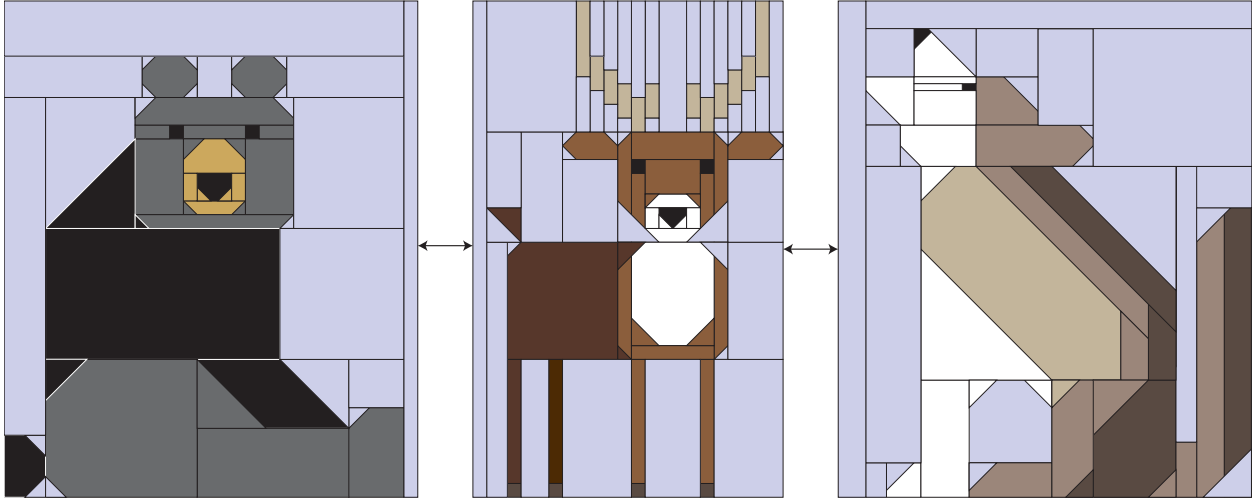


Once pressed stitch both **G** pieces, both **H** pieces and the **Canada Goose Block**, the **Raccoon Block** and the **Porcupine Block** in a row, as shown (41.75" x 11.5"). Place aside.



BOTTOM ROW

Stitch the **Black Bear Block**, the **Caribou Block** and the **Wolf Block** in a row, as shown (41.75" x 18.5").



FINAL ASSEMBLY

Stitch the **J** border pieces, the **K** sashing pieces, the **Top Row**, the **Middle Row** and the **Bottom Row** in a column, as shown (41.75" x 60.5").

Once pressed, stitch the **L** border pieces to either side of the quilt, completing the quilt top which should measure 44.75" x 60.5".
