Recommended Class Procedure

- 1. Give each student a copy of the Review Questions (one sheet at a time)
- 2. Introduce the background of the book of Luke.
- 3. Begin reading aloud, students taking turns.
- 4. After each couple of paragraphs stop and discuss questions related to the reading just completed.
- 5. Encourage students to write the answers to each question, keeping the material in a loose-leaf notebook for future study.
- 6. Continue to repeat this procedure.
