

HESSEL SCHOOL HOUSE Listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Hessel School House represents the heart of the Les Cheneaux Islands Area through its unique heritage and multi-purpose service to the community. The handsome facility is utilized by **Avery Arts and Nature Learning Center** for an extensive variety of classes and workshops, and an evolving Writers Program.

It serves as host to the Annual **Aldo Leopold Festival**, a four-day celebration of the legacy of one of America's great wilderness conservationists, who spent his early summers here on Marquette Island. Festival runs June 3-6, 2021.

It partners with **Les Cheneaux Arts Council** to provide year-round gallery exhibits, and to maintain a section of the gallery devoted to Les Cheneaux area artists in any media.






