How does it feel to you to meet this ancient woman who knows you have always been whole and who has been taking care of all the things you thought you lost, waiting for you to be ready to reclaim them?

The goblin will show you around the island and lead you to find the lost pieces of you - the bones that hold you up that help you stand tall, and supple in the world - they are all here.

Take some time to gather them together, and when you are done, bring them to the Bone woman so she can sing them back to life and place them inside you.

All the parts of you are important. You are never lost; you have never lost anything – you are whole.

Breathe in wholeness, and experience how you feel a whole being fully formed, all the parts of you accounted for.

The goblin remains. He has a task; to remind you to stay aware, to observe, and when you forget your responsibility to steward light into the world, he will warn you by telling you that you're treading on the same path again.
