Individual Membership Rebate Program for Clubs, Counties, Divisions & Statewide Orgs:

For each individual membership your club collects and submits, **your club keeps \$5!** (Not valid on online orders. The club must collect and submit applications and funds.)

\$20 E-memberships – the club sends \$15 to the state and keeps \$5 (or passes the discount along to its members).

\$35 Regular memberships – the club sends \$30 to the state and keeps \$5 (or passes the discount along to its members).

We want to hear from your club!

We take direction from our grassroots membership, and affiliated clubs like yours are the backbone of the collective work and positions we take. As a member club, your club gets to weigh in on all the issues affecting our passions and outdoor heritage. You can do this by sending a representative to our meetings, sending your club's proxy with a county representative, or responding via email, phone, or mail when issues are presented via email alerts and surveys. Your club's vote count is based on 10% of your membership numbers. Questions: Contact the state office for more information on ensuring your club's voice is heard. This is a critical component of your membership.

MEMO: Club Affiliation Forms & Instructions

PFSC Club Affiliations run on the calendar year from January 1 to December 31. All dues are due to the state office by January 1. Please use the attached club affiliation sheets. Make additional copies as needed. (The Dues rates chart is on the back of this sheet.) Interactive Version is available on the website: <https://pfsc.org/forms-%26-documents>

- **State Dues: Submit state dues** and a copy of the completed **Club Affiliation** form directly to the state office **by January 1.** (PFSC State dues must be paid to receive correspondence and to vote on issues, including election of state officers, brought before the organization.)
- **County and Division Dues: Submit directly to your county and division.** Include a copy of the Club Affiliation form with payment to your county and division. (If you need county/division contact details: info@pfsc.org) County and Division dues are required to participate at the county and division levels.
- **Club Mailing Address:** Please provide the address where you want official club notifications mailed. This can be the club's physical location, if the post office delivers mail and you have someone closely monitoring incoming mail, or an officer's mailing address.
- **Email Address: All Clubs must** provide at least **one valid e-mail contact**, as this is the timeliest and most effective way to communicate. All news alerts, important updates and event invitations are sent via email. The official club contact must be someone who will read and share the information with the club's leadership and members. You may include additional email addresses of club officers and members who would like to receive PFSC newsletters and alerts on the back of the form. Please write legibly.
- **Affiliated Club's Voting Rights:** Your voice matters! The club's vote is based on 10% of your club's reported membership numbers. (500 members = 50 votes 150 members = 15 votes)

2026 Dues Structure & Rate Chart

Club Affiliation Dues – Effective 1/1/2026
 Club Dues are Based on the Calendar Year
 January 1 – December 31

<u>Number of Members</u>	<u>Rate</u>
10-29	\$75
30-49	\$150
50-69	\$200
70-89	\$250
90-129	\$300
130+	\$300 + \$1 for each member over 129
630+	\$800 cap!

Examples:

- If your club has 200 members, you pay \$371
 - 200-129=71
 - 71x\$1=\$71
 - \$300+\$71=\$371
- If your club has 500 members, you pay \$671
- If your club has 630+ members, you pay \$800

Individual Membership Rebate Program for Clubs, Counties, Divisions & Statewide Orgs:

For each Individual membership your group collects for PFSC, you may keep \$5 and forward the balance (\$30 for regular IM and \$15 for EM) to the state.

Note: Any payments made directly to PFSC will not result in payment back to a club or group, so you must physically collect the payment and take the rebate out before submitting the balance to the state.

Statewide Organizations

State Org Dues are Based on the Calendar Year: January 1 – December 31

Statewide organizations shall be any bona fide statewide conservation organization with a membership of 300 or more whose mission is consistent with the Federation's. Statewide organizations in good standing may elect a Delegate to represent them on the PFSC Board & at General Sessions based on their level of affiliation.

Board Seat with Board Voting Privileges and General Club Voting Privileges: \$1,000

Board Seat with No Board Voting Privileges, General Club Voting Privileges Only: \$ 850

No Board Seat -General Club Voting Privileges Only: Dues based on club affiliation rates with an \$800 cap
