

1. Screening Covid-19

- 1.1). Ms. Nora has been double vaccinated and will continue to self-screen for any possible symptoms. She will only teach in person when completely symptom free. In case of any possible Covid-19 symptoms, lessons will be switched online.
- 1.2). All customers are required to participate in **passive screening** using <u>Ontario School</u> Screening Tool .

Note: While we ask all clients to email self-assessment results to musicsteps@gmail.com prior to heading to the studio, it might not always be feasible to monitor and ensure that all students and parents scheduled to attend the lessons have competed the self-assessment. Random checks will be done, and emails will be sent to those who fail to submit the self-assessment. We kindly ask you to do your part in helping us keep our studio safe for everyone!

- 1.3). Your teacher will also conduct visual check to ensure class participants do not show symptoms of illness including cough, runny nose or difficulty breathing, taking into consideration medical/ allergy conditions we have been previously notified of.
- 1.4). Any students/ parents who do not meet the screening requirements will be asked to leave the studio and join the class online.
- 1.5). Any customer who starts to experience symptoms after visiting the studio, is asked to notify the Studio once they have direction from a medical professional.

2. Control transmission risk

Physical Distancing

- 2.1). Parents/ unenrolled siblings will not be allowed to congregate in the waiting area other than when picking up or dropping off the students. Parents and students are required to wear face masks/ face covering at all times while at the studio.
- 2.2). Studio equipment is set in such a way to allow physical distancing between the students.

Waiting Area

2.3). Parents of students taking individual classes may choose to stay in the lesson room or will otherwise need to arrange for drop off and pick up.



- 2.4). No one will be allowed to remain in the waiting area, other than students waiting for pickup
- 2.5). Drop-off/ Pick-up arrangements must be in place for siblings attending consecutive classes
- 2.6). Customers are encouraged to arrive no earlier than 5 min before the start of the class to avoid overcrowding.

Personal Protective Equipment and Masks or Face Coverings

- 2.7). Ms. Nora will wear a mask or face covering at all times when at work, for as long as provincial and municipal masking policy is in-place.
- 2.8). Customers 4 years and older will be required to wear face masks/ face covering while at the studio including during the lessons, unless there is an exception due to medical reasons.

Cleaning and Disinfection

- 2.9). All commonly touched surfaces and shared areas will be cleaned daily. This includes, doorknobs, light switches, etc.
- 2.10). Students and Parents are required to disinfect hands as they enter the studio or classroom
- 2.11). Keyboards and benches will be disinfected prior to every lesson, using the disinfecting wipes.
- 2.12). All games and teaching tools used during class will also be wiped down after every use
- 2.13). Studio Director will ensure that all cleaning and disinfection products we use are Health Canada-approved as effective against COVID-19.



Hand and Respiratory Hygiene

- 2.14). Studio Director will make sure that hand sanitizer is available at the front entrance and entrance into the lesson room, for customers to use at all times
- 2.15). Disinfecting spray and wipes are available at the entrance into the washrooms and inside the washroom
- 2.17). Your instructor will wash her hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer frequently
