

## WRISTBAND POLICY FOR USE OF POOL

The Village Grove Property Owners Association thanks you for participating in our new wristband program being implemented in an effort to make our pool safer and more enjoyable for **all** our residents. Over the years, more and more under-aged, unaccompanied children are using the pool without adult supervision. This has caused additional, unnecessary and unsafe distractions for our lifeguards, and also has increased the legal liability exposure of our association as a whole. Our lifeguards are there to keep the pool water clean and healthy and to keep swimmers safe. They are not there to babysit young children. In addition, the bands will help lifeguards identify young people as community residents. Wristbands will be issued to residents in good standing (are up to date with annual or monthly HOA fee(s) and have no outstanding violations fines).

Blue wristbands are for resident children aged 14 and younger, and indicate that they must be accompanied at the pool by an adult. If they are not accompanied by an adult or have no wristband at all, the lifeguards will have them leave the pool.

Green wristbands are for teenage residents aged 15 to 18 who do not need to be accompanied by an adult. Those teens without wristbands will be asked to leave the pool.

A maximum of 4 guests per household per day may use the pool. All guests aged 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult household resident at all times. Guest wristbands are not required but the hosting residents must notify the lifeguards that they have guests with them as soon as they arrive at the pool. Failure to do so can result in guests being asked to leave.

**EVERYONE at the pool MUST obey the lifeguards at ALL times. If rules or lifeguard instructions are not followed, lifeguards will have you leave the facility immediately. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

First wristbands are being furnished at no charge. Requests for replacements will incur a fee of \$25.00 per band. Contact Shaben and Associates if you need a replacement. Board members will be at the pool on May 6, 7, 13, and 14 from 12PM to 2PM to distribute the bands. Parents must accompany their children and sign for the bands.

The pool may be reserved for parties by any resident in good standing (have no outstanding accounts or unpaid violation fines) by contacting Shaben and Associates. If the number of invited guests requires the HOA to add an additional lifeguard, the host will be charged for that cost at the current rate the HOA is charged by our pool company. Pool Parties cannot be scheduled on any days that the association is hosting a community-wide event.

Again, thank you for your cooperation in making our pool environment safer and more enjoyable. We hope you have a great summer.
